HOUSE BILL No. 5811

February 16, 2010, Introduced by Reps. Valentine, Meadows, Bauer, Jackson, Bennett, Angerer and Johnson and referred to the Committee on Ethics and Elections.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 205 (MCL 257.205), as amended by 1980 PA 398.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 205. (1) The SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), THE secretary of
- 2 state shall maintain an office in the state capitol complex —and
- 3 in other places in the state as the secretary of state HE OR SHE
- 4 considers necessary to carry out the powers and duties vested in
- 5 the secretary of state. At least 1 office shall be established in
- 6 each county of the state and in each city of the state having a
- 7 population of 10,000 or more, but not within a radius of 5 miles

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- 1 from a county office location. This subsection does not apply in a
- 2 county having a population of 300,000 or more, nor to contiguous
- 3 cities having a combined population of 10,000 or more.
- 4 (2) BEGINNING THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT
- 5 ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CEASE THE
- 6 CLOSURE, OPENING, OR CONSOLIDATION OF BRANCH OFFICES UNTIL SUCH
- 7 TIME AS THE CONDITIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTIONS (3) AND (4) ARE
- 8 FULFILLED. SUBSECTION (3) IS CONSIDERED FULFILLED WHEN A REPORT
- 9 DESCRIBING THE DECISION PROCESS IS FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF
- 10 STATE AND PUBLISHED ON THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S WEBSITE.
- 11 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL ESTABLISH, BY ADMINISTRATIVE
- 12 ORDER, A WRITTEN PROCEDURE REGARDING THE CLOSURE, OPENING, OR
- 13 CONSOLIDATION OF BRANCH OFFICES THAT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED
- 14 TO, THE FOLLOWING FACTORS:
- 15 (A) THE METHOD OF CALCULATING THE AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL SAVINGS
- 16 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE CHANGE. THE AMOUNT OF FINANCIAL SAVINGS
- 17 SHALL IDENTIFY AND PROVIDE A SPECIFIC BREAKDOWN OF THE CURRENT
- 18 OPERATIONAL COSTS, PROPOSED OPERATIONAL COSTS, AND MOVING COSTS.
- 19 THE CALCULATION SHALL ALSO DETERMINE THE LENGTH OF TIME OVER WHICH
- 20 THE COSTS ARE CONSIDERED RECOVERABLE.
- 21 (B) FACTORS DEMONSTRATING CONVENIENCE DUE TO THE CHANGE IN
- 22 LOCATION OR CONSOLIDATION. THE DETERMINATION OF CONVENIENCE SHALL
- 23 ADDRESS THE INCREASE OR DECREASE IN SPACE, POINTS OF SERVICE,
- 24 STAFFING, HOURS OF OPERATION, AND LOCATION INSOFAR AS PROXIMITY TO
- 25 THE LARGEST POPULATION CONSIDERED LIKELY TO PHYSICALLY VISIT THE
- 26 OFFICE.
- 27 (C) CLOSE PROXIMITY TO PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION.

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- 1 (D) FACTORS DEMONSTRATING ANY INCREASED EFFICIENCY IN THE
- 2 DELIVERY OF SERVICE.
- 3 (4) NOT LATER THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT SIGNS ANY
- 4 DOCUMENTATION EXECUTING THE MOVE OR CONSOLIDATION OF THE OFFICE,
- 5 THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL SEND WRITTEN NOTICE TO THE FOLLOWING:
- 6 (A) THE CHAIR OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.
- 7 (B) THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OR ADMINISTRATOR.
- 8 (C) ANY MEMBER OF THE SENATE OR THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
- 9 REPRESENTING THE DISTRICT IN WHICH THE MOVE OR CONSOLIDATION IS
- 10 OCCURRING.
- 11 (D) THE AUDITOR GENERAL.
- 12 (5) A person licensed AS A DEALER under section 248 —is not
- 13 eligible for appointment to conduct, manage, or be an employee of a
- 14 branch or fee office of the secretary of state.
- 15 (6) $\frac{(2)}{}$ A bond may be required of a person in an office
- 16 established under subsection (1) in an amount that the secretary of
- 17 state prescribes to cover the safe handling of money received under
- 18 this act. The secretary of state shall not be held personally
- 19 liable for a loss of money because of armed robbery, larceny,
- 20 embezzlement, riot, act of God, or other act of a person resulting
- 21 in a loss of money which is within the authority and responsibility
- 22 of the secretary of state as the administrator of this act.
- 23 (7) (3)—A person appointed to conduct a branch office shall
- 24 receive THE NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE OFFICE AND compensation TO BE
- 25 fixed by the secretary of state. 7 and necessary expenses of the
- 26 office. The compensation and expenses shall be paid out of the
- 27 Michigan transportation fund ESTABLISHED IN SECTION 10 OF 1951 PA

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- 1 51, MCL 247.660, and shall be deducted from the fund before the
- 2 fund is certified to the state treasurer.
