HOUSE BILL No. 5854

February 23, 2010, Introduced by Rep. Meadows and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 291, entitled

"An act to authorize state universities and colleges to enact parking, traffic and pedestrian ordinances and to provide for the enforcement of the ordinances; and to dispose of fines collected,"

by amending section 2a (MCL 390.892a), as amended by 1998 PA 441.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 2a. (1) If the violation of a particular provision of the ordinance is designated a civil infraction pursuant to section 1, the governing board may establish civil sanctions for those civil infractions, but a civil fine shall not be more than \$25.00. If the governing board establishes civil sanctions for a violation of a particular provision of the ordinance designated a civil infraction that prohibits parking in a parking space reserved for use by persons with disabilities substantially corresponding to section
