A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled

"Occupational code,"

by amending section 1201 (MCL 339.1201), as amended by 1997 PA 97.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1201. As used in this article:

2 (a) "Apprentice" means an individual engaged in learning3 cosmetology in a cosmetology establishment.

4 (b) "Braiding" means providing or offering to the general
5 public for compensation any of the following services solely for
6 development or improvement of physical qualities of the natural
7 hair structure:

(i) Intertwining in a systematic motion to create patterns in a
 3-dimensional form.

3 (*ii*) Inversion or outversion flat against the scalp along the4 part of a straight or curved row.

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(*iii*) Twisting in a systematic motion.

6 (*iv*) Extension with natural or synthetic fibers.

7 (c) "Cosmetologist" means an individual who renders or offers8 to render cosmetology services.

9 (d) "Cosmetology" means 1 of the following services or a10 combination of the following services:

11 (*i*) Hair care services.

12 (*ii*) Skin care services.

13 (*iii*) Manicuring services.

14 (*iv*) Electrology.

(e) "Cosmetology establishment" means the premises on which cosmetology or 1 or more of its services are rendered or are offered to be rendered. Cosmetology establishment does not include a school of cosmetology.

19 (f) "Electrologist" means an individual who renders or offers20 to render electrology.

(g) "Electrology" means the permanent removal of hair from thebody of an individual by the use of electricity.

23 (h) "Esthetician" means an individual who renders or offers to24 render skin care services.

(i) "Hair care services" means arranging, cutting, dressing,
curling, waving, cleansing, singeing, bleaching, coloring, tinting,
trimming, styling, relaxing, perming, straightening, or similar

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work upon the hair of the head or a wig that an individual is
 wearing.

3 (j) "Instructor" means an individual who teaches or offers to
4 teach 1 or more cosmetology services in a school of cosmetology.
5 (K) "MAKE-UP ARTISTRY" MEANS THE APPLICATION OF COSMETICS OR
6 MAKE-UP DESIGNED FOR FILM PRODUCTION, TELEVISION BROADCAST, STAGE
7 PRODUCTION, FASHION PHOTOGRAPHY, OR OTHER ENTERTAINMENT-RELATED
8 INDUSTRIES.

9 (1) (k)-"Manicuring services" means the cleansing, filing, 10 shaping, buffing, polishing, or beautifying of the nails of the 11 hands or feet, and the cleansing, massaging, stimulating, 12 exercising, or beautifying of the skin of the hands, arms, and feet, manually or with the use of tools, appliances, or cosmetic 13 14 preparations, including the repair of nails, or the creation or 15 decoration of artificial nails. Manicuring services do not include the practice of podiatric medicine and surgery as defined in 16 17 section 18001 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 18 333.18001.

(M) (*l*)—"Manicurist" means an individual who renders or offers
 to render manicuring services.

(N) (m)—"Natural hair cultivation" means techniques that
result in tension on hair strands such as twisting, wrapping,
weaving, extending, locking, or braiding of the hair by hand, which
work does not include the application of dyes, reactive chemicals,
or other preparations to alter the color or to straighten, curl, or
alter the structure of the hair.

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(O) (n)"Natural hair culturist" means a person engaged in

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natural hair cultivation but does not include a person engaged in
 natural hair cultivation if that activity is performed as part of
 the practice of a recognized religion.

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4 (P) (o) "Owner" means a person who owns and conducts a
5 cosmetology establishment or a school of cosmetology.

6 (Q) (p)—"School of cosmetology" means the premises where
7 cosmetology or 1 or more of its COSMETOLOGY services are taught.
8 SCHOOL OF COSMETOLOGY DOES NOT INCLUDE A SCHOOL THAT TEACHES, OR
9 OFFERS TO TEACH, MAKE-UP ARTISTRY.

10 (R) (q)—"Skin care services" includes the following services 11 or combination of services:

12 (i) Beautifying the skin of the body of an individual by the
13 use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or
14 creams, including body wrapping.

(*ii*) Cleansing or stimulating the skin of the body by the use of the hands, devices, apparatus, or appliances, with or without the use of cosmetic preparations, antiseptics, tonics, lotions, or creams.

19 (*iii*) The temporary removal of hair from the body of an
20 individual by the use of depilatories, waxes, razors, scissors,
21 clippers, or tweezers.

(*iv*) Giving facials, applying removable makeup, applying
eyelashes, or any other application of a preparation or beauty
enhancement to the body of an individual but does not include
applying permanent makeup or the use of tanning equipment.

26 (S) (r) "Student" means an individual engaged in learning
 27 cosmetology or 1 or more of its services in a school of

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1 cosmetology.
