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## **SENATE BILL No. 259**

February 18, 2009, Introduced by Senators RICHARDVILLE, PAPPAGEORGE, CROPSEY, HARDIMAN, GILBERT, KAHN, JANSEN and BIRKHOLZ and referred to the Committee on Families and Human Services.

A bill to create the office of the legislative child fatality investigator; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the legislative child fatality investigator, the legislative council, certain state departments and officers, and certain county and private agencies serving children.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
  "legislative child fatality investigative review act".
  - Sec. 2. As used in this act:
  - (a) "Department" means the department of human services.
  - (b) "Investigator" means the legislative child fatality investigator created in section 3.
  - Sec. 3. (1) The office of the legislative child fatality investigator is created within the legislative council.

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- 1 (2) The principal executive officer of the office of the
- 2 legislative child fatality investigator is the legislative child
- 3 fatality investigator, who shall be appointed by and serve at the
- 4 pleasure of the legislative council.
- 5 (3) The principal purpose for the investigator is to identify
- 6 specific causes and systemic problems that contribute to the
- 7 mortality of children in foster care.
- 8 Sec. 4. (1) The legislative council shall establish procedures
- 9 for approving the budget for the office, expending funds, and
- 10 employing personnel. Subject to annual appropriation, the office
- 11 shall employ sufficient personnel to carry out the duties and
- 12 powers prescribed by this act.
- 13 (2) The investigator shall establish procedures for conducting
- 14 investigations, holding hearings, and reporting findings from
- 15 investigations.

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
