## **SENATE BILL No. 271**

February 19, 2009, Introduced by Senators SCOTT, CLARK-COLEMAN, SWITALSKI, BRATER and THOMAS and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 307 (MCL 257.307), as amended by 2008 PA 36.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 307. (1) If an applicant for an operator's license or
- 2 chauffeur's license is a citizen of the United States, the
- 3 applicant shall supply a photographic identity document, a birth
- 4 certificate, or other sufficient documents as the secretary of
- 5 state may require to verify the identity and citizenship of the
- applicant. If an applicant for an operator's or chauffeur's
- 7 license is not a citizen of the United States, the applicant
- shall supply a photographic identity document and other

- 1 sufficient documents to verify the identity of the applicant and
- 2 the applicant's legal presence in the United States under
- 3 subdivision (b). The documents required under this subsection
- 4 shall include the applicant's full legal name, date of birth, and
- 5 address and residency and demonstrate that the applicant is a
- 6 citizen of the United States or is legally present in the United
- 7 States. If the applicant's full legal name differs from the name
- 8 of the applicant that appears on a document presented under this
- 9 subsection, the applicant shall present documents to verify his
- 10 or her current full legal name. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
- 11 ACCEPT AS 1 OF THE REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS AN
- 12 IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO
- 13 PRISONERS WHO ARE PLACED ON PAROLE OR RELEASED FROM A
- 14 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, CONTAINING THE PRISONER'S NAME,
- 15 PHOTOGRAPH, AND OTHER INFORMATION IDENTIFYING THE PRISONER AS
- 16 PROVIDED IN SECTION 37(4) OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953
- 17 PA 232, MCL 791.237. An application for an operator's or
- 18 chauffeur's license shall be made in a manner prescribed by the
- 19 secretary of state and shall contain all of the following:
- (a) The applicant's full legal name, date of birth,
- 21 residence address, height, sex, eye color, signature, intent to
- 22 make an anatomical gift, other information required or permitted
- 23 on the license under this chapter, and, only to the extent
- 24 required to comply with federal law, the applicant's social
- 25 security number. The applicant may provide a mailing address if
- 26 the applicant receives mail at an address different from his or
- 27 her residence address.

- 1 (b) If the applicant is not a citizen of the United States,
- 2 the applicant shall provide documents demonstrating his or her
- 3 legal presence in the United States. A person legally present in
- 4 the United States includes, but is not limited to, a person
- 5 authorized by the United States government for employment in the
- 6 United States, a person with nonimmigrant status authorized under
- 7 federal law, and a person who is the beneficiary of an approved
- 8 immigrant visa petition or an approved labor certification. The
- 9 secretary of state shall adopt rules under the administrative
- 10 procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to 24.328, as are
- 11 necessary for the administration of this subdivision. A
- 12 determination by the secretary of state that an applicant is not
- 13 legally present in the United States may be appealed under
- 14 section 631 of the revised judicature act of 1961, 1961 PA 236,
- **15** MCL 600.631.
- 16 (c) The following notice shall be included to inform the
- 17 applicant that under sections 5090 and 509r of the Michigan
- 18 election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.5090 and 168.509r, the
- 19 secretary of state is required to use the residence address
- 20 provided on this application as the applicant's residence address
- 21 on the qualified voter file for voter registration and voting:
- "NOTICE: Michigan law requires that the same address
- be used for voter registration and driver license
- 24 purposes. Therefore, if the residence address
- you provide in this application differs from your
- 26 voter registration address as it appears on the
- 27 qualified voter file, the secretary of state

- will automatically change your voter registration
- 2 to match the residence address on this application,
- after which your voter registration at your former
- 4 address will no longer be valid for voting purposes.
- 5 A new voter registration card, containing the
- 6 information of your polling place, will be provided
- 7 to you by the clerk of the jurisdiction where your
- 8 residence address is located.".
- 9 (d) For an original or renewal operator's or chauffeur's
- 10 license with a vehicle group designation or indorsement, the
- 11 names of all states where the applicant has been licensed to
- 12 drive any type of motor vehicle during the previous 10 years.
- (e) For an operator's or chauffeur's license with a vehicle
- 14 group designation or indorsement, the following certifications by
- 15 the applicant:
- 16 (i) The applicant meets the applicable federal driver
- 17 qualification requirements under 49 CFR part 391 if the applicant
- 18 operates or intends to operate in interstate commerce or meets
- 19 the applicable qualifications of the department of state police
- 20 under the motor carrier safety act of 1963, 1963 PA 181, MCL
- 21 480.11 to 480.25, if the applicant operates or intends to operate
- 22 in intrastate commerce.
- 23 (ii) The vehicle in which the applicant will take the driving
- 24 skills tests is representative of the type of vehicle the
- 25 applicant operates or intends to operate.
- 26 (iii) The applicant is not subject to disqualification by the
- 27 United States secretary of transportation, or a suspension,

- 1 revocation, or cancellation under any state law for conviction of
- 2 an offense described in section 312f or 319b.
- 3 (iv) The applicant does not have a driver's license from more
- 4 than 1 state or jurisdiction.
- 5 (f) An applicant for an operator's or chauffeur's license
- 6 with a vehicle group designation and a hazardous material
- 7 indorsement shall provide his or her fingerprints as prescribed
- 8 by state and federal law.
- 9 (2) An applicant for an operator's or chauffeur's license
- 10 may have his or her image and signature captured or reproduced
- 11 when the application for the license is made. The secretary of
- 12 state shall acquire equipment purchased or leased under this
- 13 section under standard purchasing procedures of the department of
- 14 management and budget based on standards and specifications
- 15 established by the secretary of state. The secretary of state
- 16 shall not purchase or lease equipment until an appropriation for
- 17 the equipment has been made by the legislature. A digital
- 18 photographic image and signature captured under this section
- 19 shall appear on the applicant's operator's license or chauffeur's
- 20 license. A person's digital photographic image shall be used as
- 21 follows:
- 22 (a) By a federal, state, or local governmental agency for a
- 23 law enforcement purpose authorized by law.
- 24 (b) By the secretary of state for a use specifically
- 25 authorized by law.
- 26 (c) By the secretary of state for forwarding to the
- 27 department of state police the images to persons required to be

- 1 registered under the sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295,
- 2 MCL 28.721 to 28.736, upon the department of state police
- 3 providing the secretary of state an updated list of the names of
- 4 those persons.
- 5 (d) As necessary to comply with a law of this state or of
- 6 the United States.
- 7 (3) An application shall contain a signature or verification
- 8 and certification by the applicant, as determined by the
- 9 secretary of state, and shall be accompanied by the proper fee.
- 10 The secretary of state shall collect the application fee with the
- 11 application. The secretary of state shall refund the application
- 12 fee to the applicant if the license applied for is denied, but
- 13 shall not refund the fee to an applicant who fails to complete
- 14 the examination requirements of the secretary of state within 90
- 15 days after the date of application for a license.
- 16 (4) In conjunction with the application for an operator's
- 17 license or chauffeur's license, the secretary of state shall do
- 18 all of the following:
- (a) Provide the applicant with all of the following:
- 20 (i) Information explaining the applicant's right to make an
- 21 anatomical gift in the event of death in accordance with section
- **22** 310.
- 23 (ii) Information describing the anatomical gift donor
- 24 registry program under part 101 of the public health code, 1978
- 25 PA 368, MCL 333.10101 to 333.10123. The information required
- 26 under this subparagraph includes the address and telephone number
- 27 of Michigan's federally designated organ procurement organization

- 1 or its successor organization as defined in section 10102 of the
- 2 public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10102.
- 3 (iii) Information giving the applicant the opportunity to be
- 4 placed on the donor registry described in subparagraph (ii).
- 5 (b) Provide the applicant with the opportunity to specify on
- 6 his or her operator's or chauffeur's license that he or she is
- 7 willing to make an anatomical gift in the event of death in
- 8 accordance with section 310.
- 9 (c) Inform the applicant that, if he or she indicates to the
- 10 secretary of state under this section a willingness to have his
- 11 or her name placed on the donor registry described in subdivision
- 12 (a) (ii), the secretary of state will mark the applicant's record
- 13 for the donor registry.
- 14 (d) Provide the applicant with the opportunity to make a
- 15 donation of \$1.00 or more to the organ and tissue donation
- 16 education fund created under section 217o. A donation made under
- 17 this subdivision shall be deposited in the state treasury to the
- 18 credit of the organ and tissue donation education fund.
- 19 (5) The secretary of state may fulfill the requirements of
- 20 subsection (4) by 1 or more of the following methods:
- 21 (a) Providing printed material enclosed with a mailed notice
- 22 for an operator's or chauffeur's license renewal or the issuance
- 23 of an operator's or chauffeur's license.
- 24 (b) Providing printed material to an applicant who
- 25 personally appears at a secretary of state branch office.
- (c) Through electronic information transmittals for
- 27 operator's and chauffeur's licenses processed by electronic

- 1 means.
- 2 (6) The secretary of state shall maintain a record of an
- 3 individual who indicates a willingness to have his or her name
- **4** placed on the donor registry described in subsection (4)(a)(ii).
- 5 Information about an applicant's indication of a willingness to
- 6 have his or her name placed on the donor registry that is
- 7 obtained by the secretary of state under subsection (4) and
- 8 forwarded under subsection (14) is exempt from disclosure under
- 9 section 13(1)(d) of the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442,
- **10** MCL 15.243.
- 11 (7) If an application is received from a person previously
- 12 licensed in another jurisdiction, the secretary of state shall
- 13 request a copy of the applicant's driving record and other
- 14 available information from the national driver register. When
- 15 received, the driving record and other available information
- 16 become a part of the driver's record in this state.
- 17 (8) If an application is received for an original, renewal,
- 18 or upgrade of a vehicle group designation or indorsement, the
- 19 secretary of state shall request the person's complete driving
- 20 record from all states where the applicant was previously
- 21 licensed to drive any type of motor vehicle over the last 10
- 22 years before issuing a vehicle group designation or indorsement
- 23 to the applicant. If the applicant does not hold a valid
- 24 commercial motor vehicle driver license from a state where he or
- 25 she was licensed in the last 10 years, this complete driving
- 26 record request must be made not earlier than 24 hours before the
- 27 secretary of state issues the applicant a vehicle group

- 1 designation or indorsement. For all other drivers, this request
- 2 must be made not earlier than 10 days before the secretary of
- 3 state issues the applicant a vehicle group designation or
- 4 indorsement. The secretary of state shall also check the
- 5 applicant's driving record with the national driver register and
- 6 the federal commercial driver license information system before
- 7 issuing that group designation or indorsement. If the application
- 8 is for the renewal of a vehicle group designation or indorsement,
- 9 and if the secretary of state enters on the person's historical
- 10 driving record maintained under section 204a a notation that the
- 11 request was made and the date of the request, the secretary of
- 12 state is required to request the applicant's complete driving
- 13 record from other states only once under this section.
- 14 (9) Except for a vehicle group designation or indorsement or
- 15 as provided in this subsection or section 314(5), the secretary
- 16 of state may issue a renewal operator's or chauffeur's license
- 17 for 1 additional 4-year period or until the person is no longer
- 18 determined to be legally present under section 307-THIS SECTION
- 19 by mail or by other methods prescribed by the secretary of state.
- 20 The secretary of state may check the applicant's driving record
- 21 through the national driver register and the commercial driver
- 22 license information system before issuing a license under this
- 23 section. The secretary of state shall issue a renewal license
- 24 only in person if the person is a person required under section
- 25 5a of the sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL
- 26 28.725a, to maintain a valid operator's or chauffeur's license or
- 27 official state personal identification card. If a license is

- 1 renewed by mail or by other method, the secretary of state shall
- 2 issue evidence of renewal to indicate the date the license
- 3 expires in the future. The department of state police shall
- 4 provide to the secretary of state updated lists of persons
- 5 required under section 5a of the sex offenders registration act,
- **6** 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to maintain a valid operator's or
- 7 chauffeur's license or official state personal identification
- 8 card.
- 9 (10) Upon request, the secretary of state shall provide an
- 10 information manual to an applicant explaining how to obtain a
- 11 vehicle group designation or indorsement. The manual shall
- 12 contain the information required under 49 CFR part 383.
- 13 (11) The secretary of state shall not disclose a social
- 14 security number obtained under subsection (1) to another person
- 15 except for use for 1 or more of the following purposes:
- 16 (a) Compliance with 49 USC 31301 to 31317 and regulations
- 17 and state law and rules related to this chapter.
- 18 (b) To carry out the purposes of section 466(a) of the
- 19 social security act, 42 USC 666, in connection with matters
- 20 relating to paternity, child support, or overdue child support.
- 21 (c) To check an applicant's driving record through the
- 22 national driver register and the commercial driver license
- 23 information system when issuing a license under this act.
- 24 (d) With the department of community health, for comparison
- 25 with vital records maintained by the department of community
- 26 health under part 28 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- **27** 333.2801 to 333.2899.

- 1 (e) As otherwise required by law.
- 2 (12) The secretary of state shall not display a person's
- 3 social security number on the person's operator's or chauffeur's
- 4 license.
- 5 (13) A requirement under this section to include a social
- 6 security number on an application does not apply to an applicant
- 7 who demonstrates he or she is exempt under law from obtaining a
- 8 social security number.
- 9 (14) As required in section 10120 of the public health code,
- 10 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.10120, the secretary of state shall maintain
- 11 the donor registry in a manner that provides electronic access,
- 12 including, but not limited to, the transfer of data to this
- 13 state's federally designated organ procurement organization or
- 14 its successor organization, tissue banks, and eye banks, in a
- 15 manner that complies with that section.
- 16 (15) The secretary of state, with the approval of the state
- 17 administrative board created under 1921 PA 2, MCL 17.1 to 17.3,
- 18 may enter into agreements with the United States government to
- 19 verify whether an applicant for an operator's license or a
- 20 chauffeur's license under this section who is not a citizen of
- 21 the United States is authorized under federal law to be present
- 22 in the United States.
- 23 (16) The secretary of state shall not issue an operator's
- 24 license or a chauffeur's license to a person holding an
- 25 operator's license or chauffeur's license issued by another state
- 26 without confirmation that the person is terminating or has
- 27 terminated the operator's license or chauffeur's license issued

- 1 by the other state.
- 2 (17) The secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- 3 (a) Ensure the physical security of locations where
- 4 operator's licenses and chauffeur's licenses are produced and the
- 5 security of document materials and papers from which operator's
- 6 licenses and chauffeur's licenses are produced.
- 7 (b) Subject all persons authorized to manufacture or produce
- 8 operator's licenses or chauffeur's licenses and all persons who
- 9 have the ability to affect the identity information that appears
- 10 on operator's licenses or chauffeur's licenses to appropriate
- 11 security clearance requirements. The security requirements of
- 12 this subdivision and subdivision (a) may require that licenses be
- 13 manufactured or produced in this state.
- 14 (c) Provide fraudulent document recognition programs to
- 15 department of state employees engaged in the issuance of
- 16 operator's licenses and chauffeur's licenses.
- 17 (18) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL HAVE ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO
- 18 PRISONER BIOGRAPHY INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 19 CORRECTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF VERIFYING THE IDENTITY OF A
- 20 PRISONER WHO APPLIES FOR AN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
- 21 UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
- 22 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 23 unless all of the following bills of the 95th Legislature are
- 24 enacted into law:
