A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled "Michigan campaign finance act," (MCL 169.201 to 169.282) by adding section 55b.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 55B. A CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY SHALL NOT MAKE
- 2 AN INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE UNLESS IT DISCLOSES THE AMOUNT AND
- 3 NATURE OF THE INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE TO EACH SHAREHOLDER OR MEMBER
- 4 AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE AND A
- 5 MAJORITY OF THE SHAREHOLDERS OR MEMBERS AFFIRMATIVELY CONSENT TO
- 6 THE INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE BEFORE THE INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURE IS
- 7 MADE. A CORPORATION OR JOINT STOCK COMPANY SHALL MAINTAIN RECORDS
- 8 DEMONSTRATING COMPLIANCE WITH THIS SUBSECTION, WHICH SHALL BE
- 9 PROMPTLY PROVIDED TO ANY MICHIGAN ELECTOR WHO REQUESTS THEM.
