SENATE BILL No. 1539

November 3, 2010, Introduced by Senators BRATER, THOMAS, OLSHOVE and SWITALSKI and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled "Corrections code of 1953,"

(MCL 791.201 to 791.285) by adding section 64a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 64A. (1) A PRISONER IN A STATE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY
- 2 WHOSE EXISTING HEALTH RECORD INDICATES THE PRESENCE OF ANY OF THE
- 3 CRITERIA LISTED IN SUBSECTION (3)(A) TO (C) SHALL NOT BE CONFINED
- 4 IN ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION FOR MAINTENANCE OF ORDER AND
- 5 DISCIPLINE.
- 6 (2) IF A PRISONER WHOSE EXISTING HEALTH RECORD DOES NOT
- 7 INDICATE THE PRESENCE OF ANY OF THE CRITERIA UNDER SUBSECTION
- 8 (3)(A) TO (C) IS CONFINED IN ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION FOR
 - MAINTENANCE OF ORDER AND DISCIPLINE FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN 12

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- 1 HOURS, A DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN
- 2 SHALL REVIEW THE PRISONER'S MENTAL HEALTH STATUS WITHIN THE NEXT 24
- 3 HOURS. IF THE PRISONER REMAINS CONFINED AFTER THE ASSESSMENT IS
- 4 MADE, A DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN
- 5 SHALL REASSESS THE PRISONER EVERY 3 DAYS THEREAFTER.
- 6 (3) A DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN
- 7 WHO CONDUCTS AN ASSESSMENT UNDER SUBSECTION (2) SHALL RECOMMEND FOR
- 8 REMOVAL FROM CONFINEMENT AND PLACEMENT IN AN EXISTING CORRECTIONS
- 9 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE A PRISONER WHO MEETS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
- 10 CRITERIA:
- 11 (A) THE PRISONER HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH OR CURRENTLY DISPLAYS
- 12 SYMPTOMS OF 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING AXIS I DIAGNOSES AS
- 13 DESCRIBED IN THE MOST RECENT EDITION OF THE AMERICAN PSYCHIATRIC
- 14 ASSOCIATION'S DIAGNOSTIC AND STATISTICAL MANUAL OF MENTAL
- 15 DISORDERS:
- 16 (i) SCHIZOPHRENIA OR OTHER PSYCHOTIC DISORDER.
- 17 (ii) MAJOR DEPRESSIVE DISORDER.
- 18 (iii) BIPOLAR DISORDER.
- 19 (iv) DELIRIUM OR DEMENTIA.
- 20 (B) THE PRISONER HAS BEEN DIAGNOSED WITH TRAUMATIC BRAIN
- 21 INJURY.
- 22 (C) THE PRISONER HAS BEEN DETERMINED TO BE AT RISK OF SUICIDE.
- 23 (D) THE PRISONER'S MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL CONDITION HAS
- 24 DETERIORATED SUBSTANTIALLY WHILE IN CONFINEMENT, AND A CLINICALLY
- 25 APPROPRIATE CORRECTIONS MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE IS AVAILABLE.
- 26 (4) IF A RECOMMENDATION FOR CESSATION OF CONFINEMENT AND
- 27 PLACEMENT IN A CORRECTIONS MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE IS MADE UNDER

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- 1 SUBSECTION (3), THE INMATE SHALL BE REMOVED FROM CONFINEMENT WITHIN
- 2 12 HOURS AFTER THE RECOMMENDATION IS MADE, AND THE RECOMMENDED
- 3 SERVICE SHALL COMMENCE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.
- 4 (5) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 5 (A) "ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION" MEANS CONFINEMENT TO A CELL
- 6 OR ROOM THAT IS APART FROM ACCOMMODATIONS PROVIDED FOR INMATES WHO
- 7 ARE PARTICIPATING IN PROGRAMS AT THE CORRECTIONAL FACILITY.
- 8 (B) "DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN"
- 9 MEANS A MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN EMPLOYED OR CONTRACTED BY, OR
- 10 OTHERWISE ARRANGED FOR BY, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH.
