



Senate Bill 1018 (Substitute S-1 as reported)

Sponsor: Senator Dave Hildenbrand

Committee: Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing

CONTENT

The bill would amend the public employment relations Act to do the following:

- Exclude from the definition of "public employee" a person employed by a private organization or entity who receives a government subsidy in his or her private employment.
- Provide that the exclusion could not be superseded by an interlocal agreement, memorandum of understanding, memorandum of commitment, or similar document.
- Prohibit an election being directed for, and prohibit the Michigan Employment Relations Commission or a public employer from recognizing, a bargaining unit consisting of individuals who are not public employees.
- Invalidate a bargaining unit that was formed or recognized in violation of that prohibition.

The bill states, "This amendatory act is curative, reflects the original intent of the legislature, and is retroactive."
