THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 229. (1) The commission may license a hotel or merchant, in places that the commission may designate, to sell spirits for consumption off the premises, notwithstanding section 233(1).
- 4 Except as otherwise provided in this section, if alcoholic liquor
- 5 is sold by a specially designated distributor pursuant to UNDER a
- 6 license issued under this section, it shall not be sold at less
- 7 than the minimum retail selling price fixed by the commission and
