- 6 AND PATIENT OR THE PATIENT'S PARENT, LEGAL GUARDIAN, SPOUSE, OR
- 7 OTHER LEGAL REPRESENTATIVE. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 8 (A) "ANTIEPILEPTIC DRUG" MEANS A DRUG OR THERAPEUTIC
  - FORMULATION, GENERIC OR BRAND, PRESCRIBED FOR THE TREATMENT OF
