THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 2 (A) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL
- 3 QUALITY.

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- (B) "FUND" MEANS THE ILLEGAL DUMPING REWARD FUND CREATED IN SECTION 8905E.
- (C) (a) "Litter" means rubbish, refuse, waste material, garbage, INCLUDING, BUT LIMITED TO, offal, paper, glass, cans, AND bottles; , trash, debris; , or other foreign substances; or a

- 3 (D) (b)—"Public or private property or water" includes, but is

- 15 (F) (d)—"Vessel" means a vessel registered under part 801.
- 16 SEC. 8905D. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY A REWARD TO A PERSON
- 17 WHO PROVIDES INFORMATION THAT MATERIALLY CONTRIBUTES TO THE
- 18 IMPOSITION OF A CIVIL FINE AGAINST ANY PERSON UNDER SECTION 8905A.
- 19 THE REWARD SHALL BE 50% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CIVIL FINE COLLECTED.
- 20 (2) IF MORE THAN 1 PERSON PROVIDES INFORMATION DESCRIBED IN
- 21 SUBSECTION (1) FOR A SINGLE VIOLATION, THE FIRST PERSON TO PROVIDE

- 7 THE BUSINESS VIOLATED THIS PART IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR A REWARD IF THE
- 8 EMPLOYEE INTENTIONALLY CAUSED THE VIOLATION.
- 9 (5) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE RULES THAT ESTABLISH
- 10 PROCEDURES FOR RECEIVING AND REVIEWING CLAIMS FOR PAYMENT OF
- 11 REWARDS, DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR AN AWARD, AND DETERMINING THE
- 12 MATERIALITY OF THE INFORMATION PROVIDED. IN EACH CASE BROUGHT UNDER
- 13 SECTION 8905A, WHICHEVER OFFICE PROSECUTED THE ACTION SHALL
- 14 DETERMINE WHETHER THE INFORMATION MATERIALLY CONTRIBUTED TO THE
- 15 IMPOSITION OF A CIVIL FINE.
- 16 (6) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PERIODICALLY PUBLICIZE THE
- 17 AVAILABILITY OF THE REWARDS UNDER THIS SECTION.
- 18 (7) A CLAIM FOR A REWARD UNDER THIS SECTION MAY BE SUBMITTED
- 19 ONLY FOR INFORMATION PROVIDED ON OR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF

- 21 SEC. 8905E. (1) THE ILLEGAL DUMPING REWARD FUND IS CREATED
- 22 WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY.
- 23 (2) FIFTY PERCENT OF ALL CIVIL FINES COLLECTED UNDER SECTION
- 24 8905A SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER MAY
- 25 ALSO RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY OTHER SOURCE FOR
- 26 DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE
- 27 INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE

- 7 APPROPRIATION, ONLY FOR THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES IN THE FOLLOWING

- 9 (A) PAYMENT OF REWARDS UNDER SECTION 8905D.
