A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled "The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1242.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1242. (1) NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 1, 2012, THE BOARD OF A
- 2 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF
- 3 DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A
- 4 POLICY CONCERNING THE USE OF PUBLIC RESOURCES FOR POLITICAL
- 5 ACTIVITIES. AT A MINIMUM, THE POLICY SHALL PROHIBIT EMPLOYEES,
- 6 BOARD MEMBERS, AND VOLUNTEERS FROM DOING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 7 (A) ENGAGING IN ANY LOBBYING DURING SCHOOL HOURS OR OTHER PAID
- 8 WORK TIME.

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- 1 (B) EXPENDING PUBLIC FUNDS OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
- 2 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY OR USING A
- 3 COMPUTER, COMPUTER PROGRAM, TELECOMMUNICATIONS DEVICE, ELECTRONIC
- 4 MAIL SYSTEM, OFFICE SUPPLY, VEHICLE, OR ANY OTHER PUBLIC RESOURCE
- 5 OWNED OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE
- 6 SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY FOR ANY LOBBYING.
- 7 (C) SENDING ANY POLITICAL OR LOBBYING LITERATURE OR OTHER
- 8 MATERIALS HOME WITH PUPILS OR INVOLVING PUPILS IN LOBBYING IN ANY
- 9 WAY DURING SCHOOL HOURS.
- 10 (2) NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 1, 2011, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 11 DEVELOP OR ADOPT AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL DISTRICTS,
- 12 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES A MODEL
- 13 POLICY THAT MAY BE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION.
- 14 (3) AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "LOBBYING" MEANS THAT TERM AS
- 15 DEFINED IN SECTION 5 OF 1978 PA 472, MCL 4.415.
