Sec. 42. "Police officer" means any of the following:

(a) Every A sheriff or sheriff's deputy. \div

(B) A village or township marshal. +

(C) AN officer of the police department of any city, village, or township. \div

(D) AN any officer of the Michigan state police. ; or any

(E) A peace officer who is trained and certified pursuant to the Michigan law enforcement officers training council act of 1965,
