HOUSE BILL No. 5505

March 21, 2012, Introduced by Reps. Meadows, Bauer, Hammel, Dillon, Slavens, Greimel, Irwin and Cavanagh and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to establish a program to designate, promote, and market to public entities farm products that are grown, processed, or manufactured in this state; and to prescribe the powers and duties of certain state agencies and officials.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "buy
 Michigan first act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of agriculture and rural development.
 - (b) "Farm product" means that term as it is defined in section 2 of the right to farm act, 1981 PA 93, MCL 286.472.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) The department shall establish a "Buy Michigan
 - First" program to clearly designate and encourage the purchase by

- 1 public entities of farm products grown, processed, or manufactured
- 2 in this state.
- 3 (2) The program established under subsection (1) shall be
- 4 designed to do at least all of the following:
- 5 (a) Increase opportunities to market to public entities farm

- 7 (b) Enter into partnerships with other public institutions,

- Sec. 4. As allowed by law, the department may provide for the

- 16 sale signage, stickers, posters, banners, and display cards as part
- 17 of the promotion of the sale of Michigan farm products.
- 18 Sec. 5. The department may accept funds from any private or
- 19 public source for implementation of this act.
- 20 Sec. 6. The department may promulgate rules under the
- 21 administrative procedures act of 1969, 1969 PA 306, MCL 24.201 to
- 22 24.328, to implement this act.
