THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1180. (1) NOT LATER THAN 6 MONTHS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 2 DATE OF THIS SECTION, THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
- 3 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC
- 4 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT A POLICY FOR THE HANDLING
- 5 OF MEDICAL EMERGENCIES THAT OCCUR AT SCHOOL. SCHOOL DISTRICTS,
- 6 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES ARE
- 7 ENCOURAGED TO WORK WITH LOCAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL FIRST RESPONDERS TO
- 8 ENSURE THAT FIRST RESPONDERS HAVE ACCESS TO DETAILED INFORMATION ON
