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## **HOUSE BILL No. 5842**

September 11, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Ouimet and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 2617, 2631, and 2632 (MCL 333.2617, 333.2631, and 333.2632).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2617. (1) The health information system shall include 2 statistics relative to:
  - (a) The causes, effects, extent, and nature of illness and disability of the people of this state, or a grouping of its people, which may include the incidence and prevalence of various acute and chronic illnesses and infant and maternal morbidity and mortality.
    - (b) The impact of illness and disability of the people of this

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- 1 state on the economy of this state and on other aspects of the
- 2 well-being of its people or a grouping of its people.
- 3 (c) Environmental, social, and other health hazards and health
- 4 knowledge and practices of the people of this state.
- 5 (d) Determinants of health and nutritional practices and
- 6 status, including behavior related to health.
- 7 (e) Health resources, which may include health care
- 8 institutions.
- 9 (f) The utilization of health care, which may include the
- 10 utilization of ambulatory health services by specialties and types
- 11 of practice of the health professionals providing the services, and
- 12 services of health facilities and agencies defined in section 20106
- 13 and other health care institutions.
- 14 (g) Health care costs and financing, which may include the
- 15 trends in health care prices and costs, the sources of payments for
- 16 health care services, and federal, state, and local governmental
- 17 expenditures for health care services.
- 18 (2) A PHYSICIAN OR AN INDIVIDUAL IN CHARGE OF A HEALTH
- 19 FACILITY WHO IS PRESENT FOR OR IS AWARE OF A MATERNAL DEATH SHALL
- 20 SUBMIT INFORMATION REGARDING THAT DEATH AT THE TIME AND IN THE
- 21 MANNER AS REQUIRED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR INCLUSION IN THE HEALTH
- 22 INFORMATION SYSTEM. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION:
- 23 (A) "HEALTH FACILITY" MEANS A HOSPITAL OR FREESTANDING
- 24 SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY THAT IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE
- 25 AUTHORIZED TO OPERATE IN THIS STATE UNDER ARTICLE 17.
- 26 (B) "MATERNAL DEATH" MEANS THE DEATH OF A WOMAN WHO WAS
- 27 PREGNANT AT THE TIME OF HER DEATH OR WITHIN 1 YEAR BEFORE HER

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- 1 DEATH.
- 2 (C) "PHYSICIAN" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED OR
- 3 OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE OR
- 4 OSTEOPATHIC MEDICINE AND SURGERY UNDER ARTICLE 15.
- 5 Sec. 2631. The information, records of interviews, written
- 6 reports, statements, notes, memoranda, or other data or records
- 7 furnished to THE DEPARTMENT, procured by THE DEPARTMENT, REQUIRED
- 8 TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE DEPARTMENT UNDER SECTION 2617(2), or
- 9 voluntarily shared with the department in the conduct of a medical
- 10 research project, or BY a person, agency, or organization which
- 11 THAT has been designated in advance by the department as a medical
- 12 research project which AND THAT regularly furnishes statistical or
- 13 summary data with respect to that project to the department for the
- 14 purpose of reducing the morbidity or mortality from any cause or
- 15 condition of health are confidential and shall be used solely for
- 16 statistical, scientific, and medical research purposes relating to
- 17 the cause or condition of health.
- 18 Sec. 2632. The information, records, reports, statements,
- 19 notes, memoranda, or other data described in section 2631 are not
- 20 admissible as evidence in an action in a court or before any other
- 21 tribunal, board, agency, or person. Furnishing the data to the
- 22 department UNDER SECTION 2617(2), in the conduct of a medical
- 23 research project, or to a designated medical research project does
- 24 not result in the loss of any privilege which THAT the data may
- 25 otherwise have making them inadmissible as evidence. The
- 26 information, records, reports, notes, memoranda, or other data
- 27 shall not be exhibited nor their contents disclosed in any way, in

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- 1 whole or in part, by the department or its representative, or by
- 2 any other person, agency, or organization, except as is necessary
- 3 for the purpose of furthering the STATISTICAL, SCIENTIFIC, AND
- 4 medical research project PURPOSES to which they relate consistent
- 5 with section SECTIONS 2617 AND 2637 and the rules promulgated under
- 6 section 2678. A person participating in a designated medical
- 7 research project shall not disclose the information obtained except
- 8 in strict conformity with the research project.
