## **HOUSE BILL No. 5886**

September 12, 2012, Introduced by Rep. Callton and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 20174.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 20174. (1) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 2 (A) "PRACTICE OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY" MEANS WORKING
- 3 COLLABORATIVELY WITH PERIOPERATIVE NURSES ON SURGICAL PATIENT CARE
- 4 THAT INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, THE FOLLOWING TASKS OR
- 5 FUNCTIONS:
- 6 (i) PREPARING THE OPERATING ROOM FOR SURGICAL PROCEDURES BY
- FINE ENSURING THAT SURGICAL EQUIPMENT IS FUNCTIONING PROPERLY AND
  - SAFELY.
    - (ii) PREPARING THE OPERATING ROOM AND THE STERILE FIELD FOR
- 10 SURGICAL PROCEDURES BY PREPARING STERILE SUPPLIES, INSTRUMENTS, AND

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- 1 EQUIPMENT USING STERILE TECHNIQUES.
- 2 (iii) ANTICIPATING THE NEEDS OF THE SURGICAL TEAM BASED ON
- 3 KNOWLEDGE OF HUMAN ANATOMY AND PATHOPHYSIOLOGY AND HOW THEY RELATE
- 4 TO THE SURGICAL PATIENT AND THE SURGICAL PROCEDURE BEING PERFORMED
- 5 ON THAT PATIENT.
- 6 (iv) AS DIRECTED IN AN OPERATING ROOM SETTING, PERFORMING TASKS
- 7 WITHIN THE STERILE FIELD INCLUDING ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) MAINTAINING ASEPSIS AND CORRECTING BREAKS IN THE STERILE
- 9 FIELD.
- 10 (B) PASSING SUPPLIES, EQUIPMENT, OR INSTRUMENTS ACCORDING TO
- 11 THE NEEDS OF THE SURGICAL TEAM.
- 12 (C) SPONGING OR SUCTIONING AN OPERATIVE SITE.
- 13 (D) PREPARING AND CUTTING SUTURE MATERIALS.
- 14 (E) TRANSFERRING AND IRRIGATING WITH FLUIDS.
- 15 (F) TRANSFERRING BUT NOT ADMINISTERING DRUGS.
- 16 (G) HANDLING SPECIMENS.
- 17 (H) HOLDING RETRACTORS AND OTHER INSTRUMENTS.
- 18 (I) APPLYING ELECTROCAUTERY TO CLAMPS ON BLEEDERS.
- 19 (J) CONNECTING DRAINS TO SUCTION APPARATUS.
- 20 (K) APPLYING DRESSINGS TO CLOSED WOUNDS.
- 21 (L) COUNTING SPONGES, NEEDLES, SUPPLIES, AND INSTRUMENTS WITH
- 22 THE REGISTERED PROFESSIONAL NURSE WHO IS PERFORMING CIRCULATOR
- 23 NURSE DUTIES.
- 24 (B) "SURGICAL FACILITY" MEANS A HOSPITAL, FREESTANDING
- 25 SURGICAL OUTPATIENT FACILITY, OR OTHER SIMILAR ENTITY THAT UTILIZES
- 26 SURGICAL TECHNOLOGISTS.
- 27 (C) "SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ENGAGES IN

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- 1 THE PRACTICE OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY.
- 2 (2) A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST SHALL COMPLETE 15 HOURS OF
- 3 CONTINUING EDUCATION DURING EACH CALENDAR YEAR. A SURGICAL
- 4 TECHNOLOGIST WHO HOLDS AND MAINTAINS THE NATIONAL CERTIFICATION
- 5 ESTABLISHED BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY AND
- 6 SURGICAL ASSISTING FOR THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST IS CONSIDERED TO
- 7 HAVE MET THE CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 8 A SURGICAL FACILITY THAT EMPLOYS, CONTRACTS WITH, OR GRANTS
- 9 CLINICAL PRIVILEGES TO A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST SHALL MAINTAIN
- 10 DOCUMENTATION THAT THE SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST MEETS THE CONTINUING
- 11 EDUCATION OR CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION.
- 12 (3) A SURGICAL FACILITY THAT SEEKS TO EMPLOY, CONTRACT WITH,
- 13 OR GRANT CLINICAL PRIVILEGES TO A SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST SHALL AT A
- 14 MINIMUM POST ITS SURGICAL TECHNOLOGIST JOB OPENINGS ON THE MICHIGAN
- 15 TALENT BANK, THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH INTERNET WEBSITE,
- 16 OR A SIMILAR JOB OPENING INTERNET WEBSITE OPERATED BY THIS STATE.
- 17 (4) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A HEALTH PROFESSIONAL WHO
- 18 IS LICENSED, REGISTERED, OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO ENGAGE IN A
- 19 HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER ARTICLE 15 FROM PERFORMING TASKS AND
- 20 FUNCTIONS WITHIN THE PRACTICE OF SURGICAL TECHNOLOGY IF THE
- 21 INDIVIDUAL IS ACTING WITHIN THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER LICENSE,
- 22 REGISTRATION, OR AUTHORIZATION.
