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## **SENATE BILL No. 804**

November 9, 2011, Introduced by Senators EMMONS, PAPPAGEORGE, BOOHER, SCHUITMAKER and JONES and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 18201, 18211, 18223, 18233, and 18237 (MCL 333.18201, 333.18211, 333.18223, 333.18233, and 333.18237), section 18211 as amended by 2006 PA 395, section 18223 as amended by 2010 PA 121, section 18233 as amended by 1994 PA 234, and section 18237 as amended by 1998 PA 496.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 18201. (1) As used in this part:

- (A) "CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPIST" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS ARTICLE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY.
  - (B) (a) "Psychologist" means an individual licensed under this

- 1 article to engage in the practice of psychology.
- 2 (C) (b)—"Practice of psychology" means the rendering to
- 3 individuals, groups, organizations, or the public of services
- 4 involving the application of principles, methods, and procedures of
- 5 understanding, predicting, and influencing behavior for the
- 6 purposes of the diagnosis, assessment related to diagnosis,
- 7 prevention, amelioration, or treatment of mental or emotional
- 8 disorders, disabilities, or behavioral adjustment problems by means
- 9 of psychotherapy, counseling, behavior modification, hypnosis,
- 10 biofeedback techniques, psychological tests, or other verbal or
- 11 behavioral means. The practice of psychology shall DOES not include
- 12 the practice of medicine such as prescribing drugs, performing
- 13 surgery, or administering electro-convulsive therapy.
- 14 (D) "PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY" MEANS THE RENDERING TO
- 15 INDIVIDUALS, GROUPS, ORGANIZATIONS, OR THE PUBLIC OF SERVICES
- 16 INVOLVING THE APPLICATION OF PRINCIPLES, METHODS, AND PROCEDURES OF
- 17 UNDERSTANDING, PREDICTING, AND INFLUENCING BEHAVIOR FOR THE
- 18 PURPOSES OF THE DIAGNOSIS, PREVENTION, AMELIORATION, OR TREATMENT
- 19 OF MENTAL OR EMOTIONAL DISORDERS, DISABILITIES, OR BEHAVIORAL
- 20 ADJUSTMENT PROBLEMS BY MEANS OF PSYCHOTHERAPY, COUNSELING, BEHAVIOR
- 21 MODIFICATION, HYPNOSIS, BIOFEEDBACK TECHNIQUES, OR OTHER VERBAL OR
- 22 BEHAVIORAL MEANS. THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY DOES NOT INCLUDE
- 23 THE PRACTICE OF MEDICINE SUCH AS PRESCRIBING DRUGS, PERFORMING
- 24 SURGERY, OR ADMINISTERING ELECTRO-CONVULSIVE THERAPY.
- 25 (2) In addition to the definitions in this part, article 1
- 26 contains general definitions and principles of construction
- 27 applicable to all articles in this code and part 161 contains

- 1 definitions applicable to this part.
- 2 Sec. 18211. (1) A person AN INDIVIDUAL shall not engage in the
- 3 practice of psychology unless licensed or otherwise authorized by
- 4 this article. BEGINNING ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RULES PROMULGATED
- 5 UNDER SECTION 18223(3), AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT ENGAGE IN THE
- 6 PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY UNLESS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED
- 7 BY THIS ARTICLE.
- 8 (2) The following words, titles, or letters or a combination
- 9 thereof, with or without qualifying words or phrases, are
- 10 restricted in use only to those persons authorized under this part
- 11 to use the terms and in a way prescribed in this part: "consulting
- 12 psychologist", "psychologist", "psychological assistant",
- 13 "psychological examiner", "licensed psychologist", and—"limited
- 14 licensed psychologist", "CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPIST", "LICENSED
- 15 CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPIST", AND "LIMITED LICENSED CLINICAL
- 16 PSYCHOTHERAPIST".
- 17 Sec. 18223. (1) The board shall promulgate rules requiring
- 18 that an individual granted a license under this part TO ENGAGE IN
- 19 THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY, except as provided in subsection (2),
- 20 shall meet both of the following requirements:
- 21 (a) Been granted a doctoral degree in psychology, or a
- 22 doctoral degree in a closely related field, from a regionally
- 23 accredited or other college, university, or institution approved by
- 24 the board, which included education and training appropriate to the
- 25 practice of psychology. Additionally, beginning August 1, 2011, the
- 26 doctoral degree in psychology, or the doctoral degree in a closely
- 27 related field, shall be from a program that has obtained the

- 1 association of state and provincial psychology boards' national
- 2 register designation or has been accredited by the American
- 3 psychological association or the Canadian psychological
- 4 association, or has obtained a similar designation from or been
- 5 accredited by an entity approved by the board. For purposes of the
- 6 requirement added by the amendatory act that added this sentence
- 7 2010 PA 121, a program that is in the process of obtaining this
- 8 designation or becoming accredited as required in this subdivision
- 9 before August 1, 2011, and that obtains the designation or becomes
- 10 accredited on or before August 31, 2015, meets the requirements of
- 11 this subdivision.
- 12 (b) Have not less than 1 year of postdoctoral experience in
- 13 the practice of psychology in an organized health care setting or
- 14 other arrangement, as established by the board.
- 15 (2) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY ON AND AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 16 DATE OF RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3). In addition to
- 17 section 16182, the board shall grant a limited PSYCHOLOGIST license
- 18 to an individual granted a master's degree in psychology from a
- 19 regionally accredited college, or university, or institution
- 20 approved by the board, if the individual has education, training,
- 21 and experience appropriate to the practice of psychology, as
- 22 established by the board. Except for duties performed as an
- 23 employee of a governmental entity or of a nonprofit organization
- 24 serving benevolent and charitable purposes, 2 limitations shall be
- 25 placed on a license granted to an individual under this subsection.
- 26 The limitations shall require supervision by a psychologist who has
- 27 a license other than a limited license and shall prohibit

- 1 advertising or other representation to the public which THAT will
- 2 lead the public to believe the individual is engaging in the
- 3 practice of psychology. A limited license granted under this
- 4 subsection shall be renewed pursuant to part 161. An individual
- 5 applying for a limited license pursuant to this subsection shall
- 6 have 1 year of supervised postgraduate experience in an organized
- 7 health care setting or other arrangement, as established by the
- 8 board. The individual shall be supervised by a psychologist who has
- 9 a license other than a limited license, or if a psychologist who
- 10 has a license other than a limited license is not available, by a
- 11 psychologist who has at least a master's degree in psychology and
- 12 at least 3 years of experience in the practice of psychology or by
- 13 any other individual approved by the board. The board shall issue a
- 14 temporary license to the individual for the purpose of obtaining
- 15 the 1 year of postgraduate experience.
- 16 (3) ON OR BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
- 17 DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SUBSECTION, THE BOARD
- 18 SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER A LICENSURE
- 19 PROGRAM FOR THE PRACTICE OF CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPY. BEGINNING ON
- 20 THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE
- 21 BOARD SHALL GRANT A LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF
- 22 PSYCHOTHERAPY, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION, TO AN
- 23 INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 24 (A) HE OR SHE HAS BEEN GRANTED A MASTER'S DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY
- 25 FROM A REGIONALLY ACCREDITED OR OTHER COLLEGE, UNIVERSITY, OR
- 26 INSTITUTION APPROVED BY THE BOARD, WHICH INCLUDED EDUCATION AND
- 27 TRAINING APPROPRIATE TO THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY.

- 1 (B) HE OR SHE HAS NOT LESS THAN 6,000 HOURS OF EXPERIENCE IN
- 2 THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY IN AN ORGANIZED HEALTH CARE SETTING
- 3 OR OTHER ARRANGEMENT, AS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD. THE BOARD SHALL
- 4 ONLY RECOGNIZE HOURS THAT HAVE BEEN ACCUMULATED IN NOT LESS THAN 3
- 5 YEARS OR MORE THAN 6 YEARS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A PSYCHOLOGIST
- 6 WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE. HOWEVER, IF A
- 7 PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS A LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE IS NOT
- 8 AVAILABLE, THE BOARD MAY APPROVE THAT THE SUPERVISION REQUIRED
- 9 UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION BE BY A CLINICAL PSYCHOTHERAPIST WHO HAS A
- 10 LICENSE OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE, WHO HAS AT LEAST A MASTER'S
- 11 DEGREE IN PSYCHOLOGY, AND WHO HAS AT LEAST 3 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN
- 12 THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY. THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LIMITED
- 13 LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THIS
- 14 SUBSECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING THE HOURS OF EXPERIENCE
- 15 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION.
- 16 (C) SUBJECT TO STANDARDS INCLUDED IN THE RULES PROMULGATED
- 17 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, HE OR SHE HAS PASSED THE EXAMINATION FOR
- 18 PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE OF PSYCHOLOGY AS DEVELOPED BY THE ASSOCIATION
- 19 OF STATE AND PROVINCIAL PSYCHOLOGY BOARDS.
- 20 (4) UNTIL 1 YEAR AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE RULES
- 21 PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3), THE BOARD SHALL GRANT A CLINICAL
- 22 PSYCHOTHERAPY LICENSE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HELD A LIMITED
- 23 PSYCHOLOGIST LICENSE UNDER SUBSECTION (2) ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 24 THE RULES PROMULGATED UNDER SUBSECTION (3).
- 25 (5) NOTWITHSTANDING SECTION 16182, AN INDIVIDUAL GRANTED A
- 26 LICENSE TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY UNDER THIS PART
- 27 SHALL NOT ADMINISTER, PRODUCE, OR DISTRIBUTE WRITTEN OR VERBAL

- 1 PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING, EVALUATIONS, OR REPORTS, OR DOCUMENT OR
- 2 DISTRIBUTE THAT PSYCHOLOGICAL TESTING IN A CLINICAL RECORD UNLESS
- 3 SUPERVISED AND COUNTERSIGNED BY A PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS A LICENSE
- 4 OTHER THAN A LIMITED LICENSE.
- 5 Sec. 18233. (1) In addition to the requirements of part 161,
- 6 the board may require a licensee seeking renewal of a license to
- 7 furnish the board with satisfactory evidence that during the 2
- 8 years immediately preceding application for renewal the licensee
- 9 has attended continuing education courses or programs approved by
- 10 the board totaling not less than a number of hours established by
- 11 rule of the board in subjects related to the practice of psychology
- 12 OR PRACTICE OF PSYCHOTHERAPY, AS APPROPRIATE, and designed to
- 13 further educate licensees.
- 14 (2) As required under section 16204, the board shall
- 15 promulgate rules requiring each applicant for license renewal to
- 16 complete as part of the continuing education requirement of
- 17 subsection (1) an appropriate number of hours or courses in pain
- 18 and symptom management.
- 19 Sec. 18237. A psychologist licensed or allowed to use that
- 20 title\_LICENSEE under this part or an individual under his or her
- 21 supervision cannot be compelled to disclose confidential
- 22 information acquired from an individual consulting the psychologist
- 23 LICENSEE in his or her professional capacity if the information is
- 24 necessary to enable the psychologist LICENSEE to render services.
- 25 Information may be disclosed with the consent of the individual
- 26 consulting the psychologist LICENSEE, or if the individual
- 27 consulting the psychologist LICENSEE is a minor, with the consent

- 1 of the minor's guardian, pursuant to section 16222 if the
- 2 psychologist LICENSEE reasonably believes it is necessary to
- 3 disclose the information to comply with section 16222, or under
- 4 section 16281. In a contest on the admission of a deceased
- 5 individual's will to probate, an heir at law of the decedent,
- 6 whether a proponent or contestant of the will, and the personal
- 7 representative of the decedent may waive the privilege created by
- 8 this section.
