A SUMMARY OF HOUSE BILLS 5678- 5681 AS INTRODUCED 6-12-14

The bills amend various acts to revise the definition of "public nudity" so that the phrase does not include a mother's breastfeeding of her baby or expressing breast milk.

To this end, <u>House Bill 5678</u> would amend Public Act 246 of 1945 (MCL 41.181), which authorizes township boards to adopt public health ordinances; <u>House Bills 5679 and 5680</u> would amend the Home Rule City Act (MCL 117.4i and 117.5h); and <u>House Bill 5681</u> would amend the General Law Village Act (MCL 67.1).

The bills are tie-barred to each other so that none can take effect unless all are enacted.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The bills could result in a reduction in costs for local courts if there is a decrease in caseloads. There could also be a decrease in fine revenues.
