Sec. 4. (1) "Council" means the adult foster care licensing
 advisory council created in section 8.

(2) "Department" means the department of human services.

4 (3) "Developmental disability" means a disability THAT TERM as
5 defined in section 100a of the mental health code, 1974 PA 258, MCL
6 330.1100a.

(4) "Direct access" means access to a resident or to a resident's property, financial information, medical records, treatment information, or any other identifying information.

(5) "Director" means the director of the department.

(6) "Do-not-resuscitate order" means a document executed
 according to section 3 of UNDER the Michigan do-not-resuscitate

 spontaneous respiration and circulation, no resuscitation will be
 initiated.
 (7) "Foster care" means the provision of supervision, personal
