THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XV

2 Sec. 16. When a person charged with having committed a felony 3 CRIME appears before a magistrate without counsel, and who has not 4 waived examination on the charge upon which the person appears, the 5 person shall be advised of his or her right to have counsel appointed. for the examination. If the person states that he or she 6 7 is unable to procure counsel, the magistrate shall notify the chief 8 judge of the circuit court in the judicial district in which the offense is alleged to have occurred, or the chief judge of the 9 10 recorder's court of the city of Detroit if the offense is alleged

to have occurred in the city of Detroit. Upon proper showing, the 1 chief judge shall appoint or direct the magistrate to appoint an 2 3 attorney to conduct the accused's examination and to conduct the 4 accused's defense. The attorney appointed by the court shall be entitled to receive from the county treasurer, on the certificate 5 of the chief judge that the services have been rendered, the amount 6 7 which the chief judge considers to be reasonable compensation for the services performed. APPOINT COUNSEL, IF THE PERSON IS ELIGIBLE 8 9 FOR APPOINTED COUNSEL UNDER THE MICHIGAN INDIGENT DEFENSE 10 COMMISSION ACT. 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect unless [House Bill No. 4529] 12
