SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5245

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

(MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding section 811cc.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 811CC. (1) NO LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 1, 2015, THE SECRETARY
- 2 OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP UNDER SECTION 811E AND ISSUE A THIN BLUE
- 3 LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE UNDER SECTION 811F AND A MATCHING THIN BLUE
- 4 LINE COLLECTOR PLATE AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 811G. THE SECRETARY
- 5 OF STATE IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL
- 6 DESIGN THE PLATES, HAVING THE WORDS "THIN BLUE LINE" AND "MICHIGAN"
- 7 ON THE PLATES.
- 8 (2) THE OWNER OF A VEHICLE REQUIRED TO BE REGISTERED UNDER
- 9 THIS ACT MAY APPLY, ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE,
- 10 FOR A THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING PLATE AS PRESCRIBED IN SECTION

- 1 811F INSTEAD OF A STANDARD REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 2 (3) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
- FROM THE SALE OF THIN BLUE LINE FUND-RAISING AND COLLECTOR PLATES 3
- 4 TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE
- 5 THIN BLUE LINE FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (4).
- 6 (4) THE THIN BLUE LINE FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
- 7 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
- FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER 8
- SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL 9
- 10 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
- 11 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
- 12 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND. THE STATE
- 13 TREASURER SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE FUND FOR AUDITING
- 14 PURPOSES.
- 15 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE THIN BLUE
- LINE FUND ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN, 16
- 17 P.O. BOX 415, HOWELL, MICHIGAN 48844-0415 OR A SUCCESSOR ADDRESS.
- 18 (6) THE THIN BLUE LINE OF MICHIGAN SHALL EXPEND THE MONEY
- 19 RECEIVED UNDER SUBSECTION (5) SOLELY TO ASSIST AND SUPPORT THE
- 20 FAMILIES OF INJURED OR DECEASED OFFICERS OF PUBLIC SAFETY AGENCIES
- 21 WITHIN THIS STATE.
