SUBSTITUTE FOR

HOUSE BILL NO. 5375

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code," by amending sections 20109 and 21715 (MCL 333.20109 and 333.21715),

section 20109 as amended by 1996 PA 224.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 20109. (1) "Nursing home" means a nursing care facility, 2 including a county medical care facility, that provides organized 3 nursing care and medical treatment to 7 or more unrelated 4 individuals suffering or recovering from illness, injury, or 5 infirmity. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "MEDICAL TREATMENT" INCLUDES 6 TREATMENT BY AN EMPLOYEE OR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR OF THE NURSING 7 HOME WHO IS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO 8 ENGAGE IN A HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER PART 170 OR 175. Nursing home 9 does not include a ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

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(A) A unit in a state correctional facility. Nursing home does
 not include 1 or more of the following:

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(B) (a) A hospital.

4 (C) (b) A veterans facility created under Act No. 152 of the
5 Public Acts of 1885, being sections 1885 PA 152, MCL 36.1 to 36.12.
6 of the Michigan Compiled Laws.

7 (D) (c) A hospice residence that is licensed under this
8 article.

9 (E) (d) A hospice that is certified under 42 C.F.R. CFR
10 418.100.

11 (2) "Person" means a person THAT TERM as defined in section
12 1106 or a governmental entity.

(3) "Public member" means a member of the general public who 13 is not a provider; who does not have an ownership interest in or 14 15 contractual relationship with a nursing home other than a patient contract; who does not have a contractual relationship with a 16 17 person who does substantial business with a nursing home; and who 18 is not the spouse, parent, sibling, or child of an individual who 19 has an ownership interest in or contractual relationship with a 20 nursing home, other than a patient contract.

(4) "Skilled nursing facility" means a hospital long-term care
unit, nursing home, county medical care facility, or other nursing
care facility, or a distinct part thereof, certified by the
department to provide skilled nursing care.

25 Sec. 21715. (1) A nursing home shall provide ÷
 26 (a) A program of planned and continuing nursing care under the
 27 charge of a registered nurse in a skilled facility and a licensed

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1 practical nurse with a registered nurse consultant in an

2 intermediate care facility. This subdivision shall expire December
3 31, 1979.

4 (b) A A program of planned and continuing medical NURSING care 5 AND MEDICAL TREATMENT under the charge of physicians. A NURSING 6 HOME, REGARDLESS OF ITS STATUS AS A LEGAL ENTITY, MAY EMPLOY OR CONTRACT WITH AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO 7 ENGAGE IN A HEALTH PROFESSION UNDER PART 170 OR 175 TO PROVIDE THE 8 9 PROGRAM OF PLANNED AND CONTINUING NURSING CARE AND MEDICAL 10 TREATMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, WHICH CARE AND TREATMENT INCLUDE 11 DIRECT CLINICAL SERVICES TO PATIENTS.

12 (2) Nursing A NURSING HOME SHALL PROVIDE NURSING care and medical care shall consist TREATMENT THAT CONSIST of services given 13 14 to individuals PATIENTS who are subject to prolonged suffering from 15 illness or injury or who are recovering from illness or injury. The services shall be A NURSING HOME SHALL PROVIDE THE CARE AND 16 17 TREATMENT within the ability of the NURSING home to provide and 18 shall include the functions of medical care such as TREATMENT 19 INCLUDING THE diagnosis and treatment of an illness; nursing care 20 via assessment, planning, and implementation; evaluation of a patient's health care needs; and the carrying out of required 21 22 treatment prescribed by a physician.
