## SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5389

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 21794.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 21794. (1) WITH THE CONSENT OF THE PATIENT OR THE
- 2 PATIENT'S REPRESENTATIVE A NURSING HOME MAY USE A DINING ASSISTANT
- 3 TO PROVIDE FEEDING ASSISTANCE TO A PATIENT WHO, BASED ON THE CHARGE
- 4 NURSE'S ASSESSMENT OF THE PATIENT AND THE PATIENT'S MOST RECENT
- 5 PLAN OF CARE, NEEDS ASSISTANCE OR ENCOURAGEMENT WITH EATING AND
- 6 DRINKING, BUT DOES NOT HAVE COMPLICATED FEEDING PROBLEMS,
- 7 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, DIFFICULTY SWALLOWING, RECURRENT
- 8 LUNG ASPIRATIONS, TUBE OR PARENTERAL FEEDINGS, OR BEHAVIORAL ISSUES
- 9 THAT MAY COMPROMISE NUTRITIONAL INTAKE. THE CHARGE NURSE'S
- 10 ASSESSMENT AND PLAN OF CARE MUST BE DOCUMENTED IN THE PATIENT'S

- 1 MEDICAL RECORD. FOR A PATIENT WHO IS ASSIGNED A DINING ASSISTANT
- 2 AND EXPERIENCES AN EMERGENT CHANGE IN CONDITION, THE CHARGE NURSE
- 3 SHALL PERFORM A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT TO MONITOR THE APPROPRIATENESS
- 4 OF CONTINUED UTILIZATION OF THE DINING ASSISTANT.
- 5 (2) A NURSING HOME THAT CHOOSES TO UTILIZE DINING ASSISTANTS
- 6 SHALL PROVIDE INDIVIDUALS WITH TRAINING THROUGH A DEPARTMENT-
- 7 APPROVED TRAINING CURRICULUM. THE DEPARTMENT AND THE LONG-TERM CARE
- 8 STAKEHOLDER ADVISORY WORKGROUP DESIGNATED UNDER SECTION 20155(24)
- 9 SHALL DEVELOP A DINING ASSISTANTS TRAINING CURRICULUM. THE
- 10 DEPARTMENT SHALL APPROVE A DINING ASSISTANTS TRAINING CURRICULUM
- 11 THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBSECTION. IN ORDER TO BE
- 12 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE DINING ASSISTANTS TRAINING
- 13 CURRICULUM MUST INCLUDE, AT A MINIMUM, 8 HOURS OF COURSE MATERIAL
- 14 THAT COVERS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 15 (A) DINING ASSISTANTS PROGRAM OVERVIEW.
- 16 (B) PATIENT RIGHTS.
- 17 (C) COMMUNICATION AND INTERPERSONAL SKILLS.
- (D) APPROPRIATE RESPONSES TO PATIENT BEHAVIOR.
- 19 (E) RECOGNIZING CHANGES IN PATIENTS.
- 20 (F) INFECTION CONTROL.
- 21 (G) ASSISTANCE WITH FEEDING AND HYDRATION.
- 22 (H) FEEDING TECHNIQUES.
- 23 (I) SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES.
- 24 (J) END OF LIFE.
- 25 (3) AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL NOT PROVIDE FEEDING ASSISTANCE AS A
- 26 DINING ASSISTANT IN A NURSING HOME UNLESS HE OR SHE HAS
- 27 SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED A DINING ASSISTANTS TRAINING CURRICULUM

- 1 DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (2). A NURSING HOME SHALL NOT EMPLOY OR
- 2 ALLOW AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LESS THAN 17 YEARS OF AGE TO PROVIDE
- 3 FEEDING ASSISTANCE AS A DINING ASSISTANT.
- 4 (4) A DINING ASSISTANT SHALL WORK UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A
- 5 NURSE. A DINING ASSISTANT'S SOLE PURPOSE IS TO PROVIDE FEEDING
- 6 ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS, AND HE OR SHE SHALL NOT PERFORM ANY OTHER
- 7 NURSING OR NURSING-RELATED SERVICES, SUCH AS TOILETING OR
- 8 TRANSPORTING PATIENTS. A DINING ASSISTANT IS NOT NURSING PERSONNEL
- 9 AND A NURSING HOME SHALL NOT INCLUDE A DINING ASSISTANT IN
- 10 COMPUTING THE RATIO OF PATIENTS TO NURSING PERSONNEL OR USE A
- 11 DINING ASSISTANT TO SUPPLEMENT OR REPLACE NURSING PERSONNEL. IF
- 12 APPROVED BY THE CHARGE NURSE AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (1), A
- 13 DINING ASSISTANT MAY PROVIDE FEEDING ASSISTANCE IN A PATIENT'S ROOM
- 14 IF THE PATIENT IS UNABLE TO GO TO OR CHOOSES NOT TO DINE IN A
- 15 DESIGNATED DINING AREA. A NURSE IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE PHYSICALLY
- 16 PRESENT WITHIN THE PATIENT'S ROOM DURING THE FEEDING, BUT A NURSE
- 17 MUST BE IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE. A DINING ASSISTANT WHO IS PROVIDING
- 18 FEEDING ASSISTANCE TO A PATIENT IN HIS OR HER ROOM AS PROVIDED
- 19 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST NOT BE ASSIGNED TO ASSIST ANOTHER
- 20 PATIENT AT THE SAME TIME.
- 21 (5) DINING ASSISTANTS ARE SUBJECT TO THE CRIMINAL HISTORY
- 22 CHECKS REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 20173A.
- 23 (6) A NURSING HOME THAT UTILIZES DINING ASSISTANTS SHALL
- 24 MAINTAIN A WRITTEN RECORD OF EACH INDIVIDUAL USED AS A DINING
- 25 ASSISTANT. THE NURSING HOME SHALL INCLUDE IN THE WRITTEN RECORD, AT
- 26 A MINIMUM, THE COMPLETE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE INDIVIDUAL, THE
- 27 DATE THE INDIVIDUAL SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETED THE DINING ASSISTANTS

- TRAINING CURRICULUM, A COPY OF THE WRITTEN RECORD OF THE 1
- 2 SATISFACTORY COMPLETION OF THE TRAINING CURRICULUM, AND
- 3 DOCUMENTATION OF THE CRIMINAL HISTORY CHECK.
- 4 (7) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A FAMILY MEMBER OR FRIEND
- 5 FROM PROVIDING FEEDING ASSISTANCE TO A PATIENT WITHIN THE NURSING
- 6 HOME OR REQUIRE A FRIEND OR FAMILY MEMBER TO COMPLETE THE TRAINING
- 7 PROGRAM PRESCRIBED UNDER SUBSECTION (2). HOWEVER, A NURSING HOME
- MAY OFFER TO PROVIDE THE DINING ASSISTANTS TRAINING CURRICULUM TO 8
- 9 FAMILY MEMBERS AND FRIENDS.
- 10 (8) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- (A) "DINING ASSISTANT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE 11
- 12 REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION AND WHO IS ONLY PAID TO PROVIDE
- 13 FEEDING ASSISTANCE TO NURSING HOME PATIENTS BY THE NURSING HOME OR
- 14 WHO IS USED UNDER AN ARRANGEMENT WITH ANOTHER AGENCY OR
- 15 ORGANIZATION.
- (B) "IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE" MEANS BEING CAPABLE OF RESPONDING 16
- 17 TO PROVIDE HELP IF NEEDED TO THE DINING ASSISTANT AT ANY TIME
- 18 EITHER IN PERSON OR BY VOICE OR CALL LIGHT SYSTEM, RADIO,
- 19 TELEPHONE, PAGER, OR OTHER METHOD OF COMMUNICATION DURING A
- 20 FEEDING.
- 21 (C) "NURSE" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL LICENSED AS A REGISTERED
- 22 PROFESSIONAL NURSE OR A LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSE UNDER ARTICLE 15
- 23 TO ENGAGE IN THE PRACTICE OF NURSING.
- (D) "UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A NURSE" MEANS THAT A NURSE WHO 24
- 25 IS OVERSEEING THE WORK OF A DINING ASSISTANT IS PHYSICALLY PRESENT
- 26 IN THE NURSING HOME AND IMMEDIATELY AVAILABLE.
