HOUSE BILL No. 5686

June 12, 2014, Introduced by Reps. Pscholka, Price, LaVoy, Dianda, Haveman, Foster and Schmidt and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1956 PA 40, entitled

"The drain code of 1956,"

by amending section 327 (MCL 280.327).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 327. (1) In case IF it becomes IS necessary for the 2 construction or maintenance of any highway to take the surplus 3 water across adjacent lands, the state, county or township highway 4 commissioner or county road commissioners ANY OF THE FOLLOWING may make under his or their name of office SUBMIT an application or 5 6 petition to the drain commissioner of the county OR COUNTIES in which such THE highway is situated to lay out and designate a 7 8 COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY drainage district, locate and establish a 9 COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY drain, OR clean out, widen, deepen,

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1 straighten, or extend an established COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY drain: 2 Such

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(A) THE DIRECTOR OF THE STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT.

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(B) A BOARD OF COUNTY ROAD COMMISSIONERS.

5 (C) IF A RESOLUTION IS ADOPTED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6 OF 1909 6 PA 283, MCL 224.6, TRANSFERRING THE POWERS, DUTIES, AND FUNCTIONS 7 THAT ARE OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY LAW FOR AN APPOINTED BOARD OF COUNTY 8 ROAD COMMISSIONERS, A COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS.

9 (2) AN application or petition UNDER SUBSECTION (1) shall 10 conform to the law regulating applications or petitions for the 11 laying out and designating a drainage district, locating and establishing of drains, and cleaning out, widening, deepening, 12 straightening, and extending established COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY 13 14 drains. , and shall require no other signature than his own as highway commissioner or county road commissioners. Such THE 15 application or petition shall have the same force and effect, and 16 17 be subject in other respects to the same laws and regulations that 18 govern other such applications or petitions and shall confer the 19 same jurisdiction and authority on the county drain commissioner OR 20 DRAINAGE BOARD to lay out and designate a COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY 21 drainage district, locate and establish a COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY 22 drain, or clean out, widen, deepen, straighten, or extend an 23 established COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY drain. - Provided, That in cases 24 where HOWEVER, IF the state highway commissioner makes such 25 DIRECTOR OF THE STATE TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT SUBMITS AN 26 application or petition UNDER THIS SECTION, he OR SHE shall serve a 27 copy of such THE application or petition on the director of THE

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DEPARTMENT OF agriculture AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT, who shall within 1 2 30-60 days hold a meeting at some A PUBLIC place in the VICINITY OF THE PROPOSED OR ESTABLISHED COUNTY OR INTERCOUNTY drainage district 3 4 for the purpose of determining the practicability or necessity of such THE drain, and no A board of determination shall be IS NOT 5 necessary to pass on those questions. Said THE meeting shall be 6 held, notice given, and all persons interested may be heard in the 7 same manner as provided in section 102 or section 122. of this act. 8 The determination of the director of **THE DEPARTMENT OF** agriculture 9 10 AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT shall be filed with the drain commissioner OR 11 DRAINAGE BOARD.
