SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1098

A bill to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled "Mental health code,"

by amending section 208 (MCL 330.1208), as amended by 2012 PA 500.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 208. (1) Services provided by a community mental health
- 2 services program shall be directed to individuals who have a
- 3 serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbance, or
- 4 developmental disability.
- 5 (2) Services may be directed to individuals who have other
- 6 mental disorders that meet criteria specified in the most recent
- 7 diagnostic and statistical manual of mental health disorders
- 8 published by the American psychiatric association and may also be
- 9 directed to the prevention of mental disability and the promotion
- 10 of mental health. Resources that have been specifically designated

- 1 to community mental health services programs for services to
- 2 individuals with dementia, alcoholism, or substance use disorder or
- 3 for the prevention of mental disability and the promotion of mental
- 4 health shall be utilized for those specific purposes.
- 5 (3) Priority shall be given to the provision of services to
- 6 individuals with the most severe forms of serious mental illness,
- 7 serious emotional disturbance, and developmental disability.
- 8 Priority shall also be given to the provision of services to
- 9 individuals with a serious mental illness, serious emotional
- 10 disturbance, or developmental disability in urgent or emergency
- 11 situations. PRIORITY SHALL ALSO BE GIVEN TO THE PROVISION OF
- 12 SERVICES TO CHILDREN WHO REQUIRE ANY LEVEL OF MENTAL HEALTH
- 13 TREATMENT AND WHO ARE PLACED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES
- 14 INTO RESIDENTIAL FOSTER CARE. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION,
- 15 "RESIDENTIAL FOSTER CARE" MEANS A CHILD CARING INSTITUTION OR A
- 16 PRIVATE HOME AS THOSE TERMS ARE DEFINED IN SECTION 1 OF 1973 PA
- 17 116, MCL 722.111.
- 18 (4) An individual shall not be denied a service because an
- 19 individual who is financially liable is unable to pay for the
- 20 service.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect July 1,
- 2015.
