

# HOUSE BILL No. 4477

March 19, 2013, Introduced by Reps. Schor, LaVoy and Kivela and referred to the Committee on Elections and Ethics.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled  
"Michigan election law,"  
(MCL 168.1 to 168.992) by adding section 736h.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 736H. (1) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ACT  
2 TO THE CONTRARY AND SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (2), AN ELECTOR MAY USE A  
3 CAMERA, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A CELLULAR TELEPHONE CAMERA,  
4 IN A POLLING PLACE TO TAKE A PHOTOGRAPH OF HIMSELF OR HERSELF.

5           (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT AUTHORIZE AN ELECTOR TO USE A  
6 CAMERA, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A CELLULAR TELEPHONE CAMERA,  
7 IN A POLLING BOOTH OR VOTING COMPARTMENT OR TO TAKE A PHOTOGRAPH OF  
8 HIS OR HER ELECTION BALLOT.
