Sec. 205. An employer, labor organization, or joint labormanagement committee controlling an apprenticeship, on the job, or
other training or retraining program, shall not discriminate
against an individual because of religion, race, color, national
origin, age, sex, height, weight, or marital status, in admission
to, or employment or continuation in, a program established to
provide apprenticeship on the job, or other training or retraining.
