A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled

"Public health code,"

by amending sections 18107 and 18111 (MCL 333.18107 and 333.18111), section 18107 as amended by 1989 PA 262 and section 18111 as added by 1988 PA 421, and by adding section 18108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 18107. (1) The board may grant a professional counselor
 license to an individual who is or does all of the following:

(a) Is not less than 21 years of age.

4 (b) Has received a masters MASTER'S or doctoral degree in
5 counseling or student personnel work in a program approved by the
6 board. The SUBJECT TO SECTION 18108, THE board shall promulgate
7 rules to establish standards to approve only those programs that
8 include graduate studies in the following areas: research, group

techniques, counseling theories, ethics, counseling techniques,
 counseling philosophy, testing procedures, career development,
 consulting, practicum, and internship.

4 (c) Has FOR A LICENSE GRANTED ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1994, HAS at least 2 years of counseling experience under the supervision of 5 a licensed professional counselor. The board may decrease the 6 required length of counseling experience under the supervision of a 7 licensed professional counselor to 1 year if an applicant has 8 9 completed 30 hours of graduate study in counseling beyond the 10 master's degree. An applicant shall not be licensed before 11 completing 1 year of counseling experience under the supervision of 12 a licensed professional counselor. This subdivision shall take 13 effect on October 1, 1994.

14 (2) By BEFORE October 1, 1993, an individual who meets the
15 requirement of subsection (1)(a), has 2 years of experience, and
16 holds a master's or doctoral degree in counseling or student
17 personnel work that does not meet the requirements of subsection
18 (1)(b), may be granted a license by the board.

SEC. 18108. FOR PURPOSES OF SECTIONS 18107 AND 18111, THE
BOARD SHALL NOT DO ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

(A) APPROVE AN EDUCATION PROGRAM UNDER THIS PART UNLESS THE
PROGRAM HAS A WRITTEN POLICY IN EFFECT THAT PROHIBITS A STUDENT
FROM BEING EXCLUDED, EXPELLED, OR OTHERWISE DISCRIMINATED AGAINST
BECAUSE HE OR SHE REFUSES TO PROVIDE COUNSELING THAT MAY RESULT IN
GOALS, OUTCOMES, OR BEHAVIORS THAT VIOLATE THE RELIGIOUS BELIEFS OF
THE STUDENT.
