HOUSE BILL No. 5996

December 2, 2014, Introduced by Rep. Price and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 328, entitled

"An act to regulate animals running at large; to provide for compensation for damage done by animals running at large; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending sections 5 and 6 (MCL 433.15 and 433.16).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 5. A law enforcement agency which THAT takes custody or possession of an animal under this act shall DO BOTH OF THE

 FOLLOWING:
 - (a) If the owner of the animal is known, return the animal to its owner, unless the owner refuses to make reparation as provided in UNDER section 3.
 - (b) If BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, IF the owner of the animal is

- 1 not known, give notice in a newspaper of general circulation in the
- 2 area that the animal is in the custody or possession of the law
- 3 enforcement agency. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2015, IF THE OWNER OF THE
- 4 ANIMAL IS NOT KNOWN, GIVE TIER B PUBLIC NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE
- 5 LOCAL GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT THAT THE ANIMAL IS IN THE
- 6 CUSTODY OR POSSESSION OF THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY. The notice
- 7 REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION shall include a description of the
- 8 animal and the location where the animal was seized. If the animal
- 9 is not claimed within 15 days after publication of the notice, the
- 10 animal may be sold at public auction pursuant to UNDER section 6.
- 11 Sec. 6. (1) A law enforcement agency which THAT has in its
- 12 custody or possession an unclaimed animal for not less than 15 days
- 13 after giving notice as required in section 5_{τ} may sell the animal
- 14 at public auction.
- 15 (2) Notice—BEFORE JANUARY 1, 2015, NOTICE of the public
- 16 auction shall be given in a newspaper of general circulation in the
- 17 area not less than 21 nor more than 30 days prior to the day of
- 18 sale. BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 2015, NOTICE OF THE PUBLIC AUCTION SHALL
- 19 BE GIVEN AT LEAST 14 DAYS BUT NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS BEFORE THE DAY
- 20 OF SALE USING TIER B PUBLIC NOTICE AS PROVIDED IN THE LOCAL
- 21 GOVERNMENT PUBLIC NOTICE ACT. The notice REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 22 SUBSECTION shall list the number and species of animals to be sold
- 23 and shall specify the time and place of the sale.
- 24 (3) The animals shall be sold to the highest bidder at the
- 25 auction. The proceeds derived from the sale of the animals shall be
- 26 used first to pay any expenses incurred by the law enforcement
- 27 agency in caring for and keeping the animals; second, to pay the

- 1 expenses of the sale; and third, any balance remaining shall be
- 2 paid to the city or township treasurer of the city or township in
- 3 which the animal was seized and credited to the general fund of
- 4 that city or township.
- 5 (4) An animal sold pursuant to UNDER this section may be
- 6 redeemed at any time within 3 months following the sale, if the
- 7 owner pays the sale purchaser the amount paid at the sale plus $\frac{a}{b}$
- 8 reasonable compensation for the care and keeping of the animal.
- 9 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 10 unless House Bill No. 5560 of the 97th Legislature is enacted into
- **11** law.
