9	Sec. 201. In accordance with the provisions of section 30 of
10	article IX of the state constitution of 1963, total state spending
11	from state resources in this appropriation act for the fiscal year
12	ending September 30, 2013 is \$23,538,700.00. State appropriations
13	paid to local units of government are \$19,778,700.00 as follows:

17	Sec. 202. The appropriations authorized under this act are
18	subject to the management and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101
19	to 18.1594.
20	DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
21	Sec. 301. (1) The department of natural resources shall enter
22	into agreements with local units of government for the purpose of
23	administering the grants identified in part 1. Among other
24	provisions, the agreements shall require that grant recipients

- 1 agree to dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in perpetuity
- 2 the land acquired or developed; to replace lands converted or lost
- 3 to other than public outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels
- 4 acquired that are over 5 acres in size, to provide the state with a
- 5 nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any acquired
- 6 minerals that are retained by the grant recipient.
- 7 (2) The agreements under subsection (1) shall also provide
- 8 that the full payments of grants shall be made only after proof of
- 9 acquisition, or proof of completion of the development project, is
- 10 submitted by the grant recipient and all costs are verified by the
- 11 department of natural resources. This requirement may be waived by
- 12 the department of natural resources.
- Sec. 302. The appropriations in part 1 for capital outlay
- 14 shall be carried forward at the end of the fiscal year consistent
- 15 with the provisions of section 248 of the management and budget
- 16 act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1248.
