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SENATE BILL No. 268

March 19, 2013, Introduced by Senators HUNTER, HANSEN, COLBECK, JONES, MARLEAU, JANSEN and GREEN and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 224 (MCL 257.224), as amended by 2012 PA 491.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 224. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this act regarding tabs or stickers, upon registering a vehicle, the secretary of state shall issue to the owner 1 registration plate.
- (2) A registration plate shall display the registration number assigned to the vehicle for which the registration plate is issued; the name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and when the registration plate expires, which may be shown by a tab or sticker furnished by the secretary of state.
 - (3) A registration plate issued for motor vehicles owned and

- 1 operated by this state; a state institution; a municipality; a
- 2 privately incorporated, nonprofit volunteer fire department; or a
- 3 nonpublic, nonprofit college or university of this state shall not
- 4 expire at any particular time but shall be renewed when the
- 5 registration plate is worn out or is illegible. This registration
- 6 plate shall be assigned upon proper application and payment of the
- 7 applicable fee and may be used on any eligible vehicle titled to
- 8 the applicant if a written record is kept of the vehicles upon
- 9 which the registration plate is used. The written record shall
- 10 state the time the registration plate is used on a particular
- 11 vehicle. The record shall be open to inspection by a law
- 12 enforcement officer or a representative of the secretary of state.
- 13 (4) A registration plate issued for a vehicle owned by the
- 14 civil air patrol as organized under 36 USC 201 to 208; a vehicle
- 15 owned by a nonprofit organization and used to transport equipment
- 16 for providing dialysis treatment to children at camp; an emergency
- 17 support vehicle used exclusively for emergencies and owned and
- 18 operated by a federally recognized nonprofit charitable
- 19 organization; a vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit veterans
- 20 center; a motor vehicle having a truck chassis and a locomotive or
- 21 ship's body which THAT is owned by a nonprofit veterans
- 22 organization and used exclusively in parades and civic events; a
- 23 vehicle owned and operated by a nonprofit recycling center or a
- 24 federally recognized nonprofit conservation organization until
- 25 December 31, 2000; a motor vehicle owned and operated by a senior
- 26 citizen center; and a registration plate issued for buses including
- 27 station wagons, carryalls, or similarly constructed vehicles owned

- 1 and operated by a nonprofit parents' transportation corporation
- 2 used for school purposes, parochial school, society, church Sunday
- 3 school, or other grammar school, or by a nonprofit youth
- 4 organization or nonprofit rehabilitation facility shall be issued
- 5 upon proper application and payment of the applicable tax provided
- 6 in section 801(1)(g) or (h) to the applicant for the vehicle
- 7 identified in the application. The vehicle shall be used
- 8 exclusively for activities of the school or organization and shall
- 9 be designated by proper signs showing the school or organization
- 10 operating the vehicle. The registration plate shall expire EXPIRES
- 11 on December 31 in the fifth year following the date of issuance.
- 12 The registration plate may be transferred to another vehicle upon
- 13 proper application and payment of a \$10.00 transfer fee.
- 14 (5) The department shall not issue or transfer a standard
- 15 design beads on paint registration plate or issue a registration
- 16 tab or sticker for that plate, but shall offer a new standard
- 17 design registration plate that complies with the requirements of
- 18 this act. The new standard design registration plate shall be of a
- 19 common color scheme and design that is made of fully reflectorized
- 20 material and shall be clearly visible at night. AS AN ALTERNATIVE
- 21 TO THE STANDARD DESIGN REGISTRATION PLATE REQUIRED UNDER THIS
- 22 SUBSECTION, THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL DEVELOP AND OFFER A
- 23 VEHICLE REGISTRATION PLATE WITH THE WORDS "IN GOD WE TRUST"
- 24 INSCRIBED ON THE PLATE. THE "IN GOD WE TRUST" VEHICLE REGISTRATION
- 25 PLATE SHALL COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ACT. The
- 26 implementation of this subsection is contingent upon appropriations
- 27 sufficient to cover the costs to the department of designing,

- 1 manufacturing, distributing, and issuing the new standard design
- 2 registration plate. The secretary of state shall file a written
- 3 report with the secretary of the senate and the clerk of the house
- 4 of representatives of the costs incurred and revenue expended to
- 5 meet the requirements of this subsection within 30 days after all
- 6 of the standard design beads on paint registration plates to be
- 7 replaced under this subsection have been replaced.
- 8 (6) The department may use the Pure Michigan brand or a
- 9 successor or similar brand that is used in conjunction with the
- 10 state's promotion, travel, and tourism campaigns or marketing
- 11 efforts as part of the standard design for registration plates.
- 12 (7) The registration plate and the required letters and
- 13 numerals on the registration plate shall be of sufficient size to
- 14 be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight.
- 15 The secretary of state may issue a tab or tabs designating the
- 16 month and year of expiration.
- 17 (8) The secretary of state shall issue for every passenger
- 18 motor vehicle rented without a driver the same type of registration
- 19 plate as the type of registration plate issued for private
- 20 passenger vehicles.
- 21 (9) A person shall not operate a vehicle on the public
- 22 highways or streets of this state displaying a registration plate
- 23 other than the registration plate issued for the vehicle by the
- 24 secretary of state, except as provided in this chapter for
- 25 nonresidents, and by assignment provided in subsection (3).
- 26 (10) The registration plate displayed on a vehicle registered
- 27 on the basis of elected gross weight shall indicate the elected

 ${f 1}$ gross weight for which the vehicle is registered.
