

# SENATE BILL No. 354

May 8, 2013, Introduced by Senators JONES, ROCCA, ANDERSON, PROOS, MARLEAU, PAPPAGEORGE and NOFS and referred to the Committee on Agriculture.

A bill to amend 1969 PA 287, entitled

"An act to regulate pet shops, animal control shelters, and animal protection shelters; to establish uniform procedures and minimum requirements for adoption of dogs, cats, and ferrets; and to prescribe penalties and civil fines and to provide remedies,"

(MCL 287.331 to 287.340) by adding section 8b.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 8B. (1) BEGINNING 60 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE  
2 AMENDATORY ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, EUTHANASIA OF A DOG OR CAT  
3 THAT IS UNDER THE CONTROL OF AN ANIMAL CONTROL SHELTER SHALL ONLY  
4 BE PERFORMED BY ADMINISTERING AN INJECTION OF A COMMERCIALY  
5 PREPARED SOLUTION AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 7333 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH  
6 CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.7333.

7           (2) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO OR  
8 PROHIBIT THE LAWFUL KILLING OR OTHER USE OF AN ANIMAL IN FARMING OR

1 A GENERALLY ACCEPTED ANIMAL HUSBANDRY OR FARMING PRACTICE INVOLVING  
2 LIVESTOCK.
