- 1 SEC. 625J. (1) IF IT APPEARS FROM THE RESULTS OF A PRELIMINARY
- 2 CHEMICAL ANALYSIS ADMINISTERED UNDER SECTION 625G THAT A CONTROLLED
- 3 SUBSTANCE IS PRESENT IN THE PERSON'S BODY, THE PEACE OFFICER WHO
- 4 ADMINISTERED THE PRELIMINARY CHEMICAL ANALYSIS SHALL WITHIN 72
- 5 HOURS ENTER THAT INFORMATION INTO LEIN, INDICATING THAT A
- 6 SUBSEQUENT CHEMICAL TEST IS PENDING.
- 7 (2) IF THE RESULTS OF A SUBSEQUENT CHEMICAL TEST ADMINISTERED
- 3 UNDER SECTION 625A(6) TO A PERSON DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (1)
- 9 REVEAL THE ABSENCE OF A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE IN THE PERSON'S BODY,
  - THE PEACE OFFICER SHALL REMOVE THE INFORMATION ENTERED INTO LEIN
