THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21527. (1) If an individual alleges to a physician or

other member of the attending or admitting staff of a hospital that within the preceding 24—120 hours the individual has been the victim of criminal sexual conduct under sections 520a to 520*l* of the Michigan penal code, Act No. 328 of the Public Acts of 1931, being sections—1931 PA 328, MCL 750.520a to 750.520 *l* of the Michigan Compiled Laws, 750.520*l*, the attending health care personnel responsible for examining or treating the individual immediately shall inform the individual of the availability of a sexual assault
