SENATE BILL No. 1094

September 30, 2014, Introduced by Senators WARREN, BIEDA, ANANICH and JONES and referred to the Committee on Families, Seniors and Human Services.

A bill to amend 1974 PA 258, entitled "Mental health code,"

by amending section 208 (MCL 330.1208), as amended by 2012 PA 500.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 208. (1) Services provided by a community mental health services program shall be directed to individuals who have a serious mental illness, serious emotional disturbance, or developmental disability.

(2) Services may be directed to individuals who have other mental disorders that meet criteria specified in the most recent diagnostic and statistical manual of mental health disorders published by the American psychiatric association and may also be directed to the prevention of mental disability and the promotion of mental health. Resources that have been specifically designated
