

HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR  
SENATE BILL NO. 985

A bill to amend 1982 PA 295, entitled  
"Support and parenting time enforcement act,"  
by amending section 24a (MCL 552.624a), as amended by 2002 PA 572.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1       Sec. 24a. For a friend of the court case, if a support  
2 arrearage has accrued and there is reason to believe the payer  
3 transferred title or ownership of real or personal property without  
4 fair consideration, the title IV-D agency shall initiate  
5 proceedings to have the transfer set aside as provided in the  
6 uniform ~~fraudulent transfer~~ **VOIDABLE TRANSACTIONS** act, 1998 PA 434,  
7 MCL 566.31 to ~~566.43,~~ **566.45**, or obtain a settlement in the form of  
8 full payment of the arrearage or in periodic repayments as is  
9 possible in the best interest of the recipient of support.  
10       Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.

2 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
3 unless Senate Bill No. 982 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into  
4 law.
