A bill to amend 1990 PA 187, entitled "The pupil transportation act,"

by amending section 57 (MCL 257.1857), as amended by 2006 PA 108.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 57. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2), (3), and
- 2 (4), AND (5), the driver of a school bus, before crossing a
- 3 railroad track at grade, shall stop the vehicle within 50 feet but
- 4 not less than 15 feet from the nearest rail, activate hazard
- 5 warning lights, turn off all interior switches including fans,
- 6 heaters, and radios, open the passenger door and driver-side
- 7 window, and while stopped shall listen and look in both directions
- 8 along the track for an approaching train and for signals indicating
- 9 the approach of a train, and shall not proceed until the driver can
 - do so safely. After stopping as required in this subsection, and

- 1 upon proceeding when it is safe to do so, the driver of the vehicle
- 2 shall cross only in a gear of the vehicle that does not require
- 3 changing gears while traversing the crossing. The driver shall not

- 5 (2) A stop need not be made at a railroad track grade crossing
- 6 where a uniformed police officer or a traffic-control signal
- 7 directs traffic to proceed.
- 8 (3) A stop need not be made at an abandoned INACTIVE railroad
- 9 track grade crossing. As used in this subsection, "abandoned
- 10 "INACTIVE railroad track" means a railroad track which THAT meets
- 11 both of the following requirements:
- 12 (a) The track has been completely paved over or removed.
- 13 (b) All signs, signals, and other warning devices are removed.

- 22 AFTER NOTICE TO AND AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD BY THE PRIMARY
- 23 RAILROAD OPERATING OVER THAT CROSSING.
- 24 (6) (5) A person who violates this section is responsible for
- 25 a civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of not
- 26 more than \$100.00. A civil infraction under this subsection shall
