## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5701. (1) As used in this part:
- 2 (a) "Agent orange" means the chemical herbicide made from
- 3 chemicals known as 2,4-Dichlorophenoxyacetic acid and its esters,
- 4 or 2,4-D, and Trichlorophenoxyacetic acid and its esters, or 2,4,5-
- 5 T.

- 6 (b) "Chemical agent" means a chemical herbicide or defoliant
  - other than agent orange, or a chemical weapon, which chemical
- 8 herbicide, defoliant, or weapon is of the type used by the armed
- 9 forces of the United States.
  - (c) "Commission" means the agent orange commission created in
- **11** section 5731.

- 18 (i) Has been a resident of this state continuously since the
- 19 effective date of this part.JUNE 11, 1987.
- 20 (ii) Is a resident of this state at the time he or she begins
- 21 participating in testing or other activities under this part, and
- 22 was a resident of this state at the time of induction into the
- 23 armed forces of the United States.
- 24 (2) In addition, article 1 contains general definitions and
