2 the legislature, the governor shall submit to the legislature and 3 the fiscal agencies executive budget bills containing itemized 4 statements of estimated state spending to be paid to local units of 5 government; -- ANNUAL REQUIRED EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS TOWARD TOTAL UNFUNDED RETIREE HEALTH CARE AND PENSION LEGACY COSTS AS DETERMINED 6 7 BY THE STATE'S CONSULTING ACTUARY FOR EACH DEPARTMENT AND THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH AND THE JUDICIAL BRANCH; individual line item 9 amounts, including the number of FTE positions to be funded by each individual line item amount, for the proposed expenditures; and any 10

necessary bills for additional revenue to provide financing for the

- proposed expenditures.
- 2 (2) One executive budget bill and 1 enacted budget bill shall
- 3 contain all of the following:
- 4 (a) The estimated revenue for each state operating fund in

- 6 (b) Summary totals for each state operating fund to reflect
- 7 that recommended expenditures for each fund are within proposed and
- 8 estimated resources.
- 9 (c) A statement of estimated state spending to be paid to
- 10 units of local government, total state spending from state sources
- 11 of financing, and the state-local proportion derived from that
- 12 data.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
