## SENATE BILL NO. 988

A bill to amend 2000 PA 489, entitled

"Michigan trust fund act,"

by amending sections 2 and 6 (MCL 12.252 and 12.256), section 2 as amended by 2016 PA 193, and by adding section 11.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Community district education trust fund" means the
3 community district education trust fund created in section 12.

4 (B) "HEALTH SERVICES FUND" MEANS THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND
5 CREATED IN SECTION 11.

6 (C) (b)—"Medicaid benefits trust fund" means the Michigan
7 Medicaid benefits trust fund established in section 5.

(D) <del>(c)</del>"Medicaid program" means a program for medical

assistance established under title XIX of the social security act,
 42 USC 1396 to 1396w-5.

3 (E) (d)—"Medicaid special financing payments" means the
4 Medicaid special adjustor payments each year authorized in the
5 department of community health appropriations act.

6 (F) (e)—"Michigan merit award trust fund" means the Michigan
7 merit award trust fund established in section 9.

8 (G) (f) "Tobacco settlement revenue" means money received by
9 this state that is attributable to the master settlement agreement
10 incorporated into a consent decree and final judgment entered into
11 on December 7, 1998 in <u>Kelly Ex Rel. Michigan v Philip Morris</u>
12 <u>Incorporated, et al.</u>, Ingham County circuit court, docket no. 9613 84281CZ, including any rights to receive money attributable to the
14 master settlement agreement that has been sold by this state.

(H) (g) "21st century jobs trust fund" means the 21st century
 jobs trust fund established in section 7.

Sec. 6. The legislature shall authorize the expenditure of
 medicaid MEDICAID benefits trust fund revenues through an
 appropriation act only for 1 or more of the following purposes:

20 (a) To finance a shortfall in the medicaid MEDICAID program
21 due to a disallowance of medicaid MEDICAID payments from the
22 federal government.

23 (b) To offset any decline in revenue caused by federal
24 medicaid MEDICAID policy changes.

25 (C) FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

26 SEC. 11. (1) THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE 27 STATE TREASURY.

(2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM
 ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND. THE STATE
 TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND.
 THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND
 INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM HEALTH SERVICES FUND INVESTMENTS.

6 (3) MONEY IN THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE 7 FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND AND SHALL NOT 8 LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

9 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF
 10 THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

(5) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE
HEALTH SERVICES FUND, UPON APPROPRIATION, ONLY AS PROVIDED IN THIS
SECTION. ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
MAKE A DISTRIBUTION FROM THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND IN THE FOLLOWING
ORDER OF PRIORITY:

(A) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, NOT LESS THAN \$2,000,000.00 TO THE 16 17 FUND DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5402 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND 18 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.5402. THE FUNDS 19 DISTRIBUTED SUBJECT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY 20 FOR ASSISTING QUALIFIED WATER SUPPLIERS IN SATISFYING THE 21 REQUIREMENTS OF THE FEDERAL SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5402 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION 22 23 ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.5402, AND FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF LOW-24 INTEREST LOANS AND GRANTS TO COMMUNITY AND NONCOMMUNITY QUALIFIED 25 WATER SUPPLIERS.

(B) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, NOT LESS THAN \$100,000,000.00 SHALL
 BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR

COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH NON-MEDICAID SERVICES. NO LESS THAN 5% OF
 THE FUNDS DISTRIBUTED SUBJECT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE USED TO
 SUPPORT STATEWIDE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCE INTERVENTION
 SERVICES.

5 (C) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, NOT LESS THAN \$30,000,000.00 SHALL
6 BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR
7 LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH FOR NON-MEDICAID SERVICES.

8 (D) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN 9 THIS SUBDIVISION, NOT LESS THAN \$204,000,000.00 SHALL BE 10 DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE 11 FEDERAL MEDICARE PHARMACEUTICAL PROGRAM. FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-12 2017 ONLY, NOT LESS THAN \$150,000,000.00 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO 13 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE FEDERAL 14 MEDICARE PHARMACEUTICAL PROGRAM.

15 (E) AFTER THE DISTRIBUTIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISIONS (A) TO 16 (D), AN AMOUNT THAT EQUALS THE REMAINING FUNDS AVAILABLE SHALL BE 17 DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR CLINICAL AND 18 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

19 (6) MONEY DEPOSITED INTO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND PURSUANT TO 20 THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE USED FOR ANY MEDICAID BENEFITS PROVIDED 21 UNDER THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CREATED UNDER SECTIONS 105 AND 22 105D OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.105 AND 23 400.105D, OR FOR THE MEDICAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION WITHIN THE 24 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF 25 THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CREATED UNDER SECTIONS 105 AND 105D 26 OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.105 AND 400.105D. 27 Enacting section 1.
