SENATE BILL No. 988

May 24, 2016, Introduced by Senators STAMAS, SHIRKEY, PROOS, HORN and MACGREGOR and referred to the Committee on Michigan Competitiveness.

A bill to amend 2000 PA 489, entitled

"Michigan trust fund act,"

by amending sections 2 and 6 (MCL 12.252 and 12.256), section 2 as amended by 2005 PA 232, and by adding section 11.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

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Sec. 2. As used in this act:

2 (A) "HEALTH SERVICES FUND" MEANS THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND
3 CREATED IN SECTION 11.

(B) (a)—"Medicaid benefits trust fund" means the Michigan medicaid MEDICAID benefits trust fund established in section 5.

(C) (b) "Medicaid program" means a program for medical assistance established under title XIX of the social security act, chapter 531, 49 Stat. 620, 42 USC 1396 to 1396f, 1396g-1 to 1396r-6, and 1396r 8 to 1396v.1396W-5.

(D) (c) "Medicaid special financing payments" means the

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medicaid MEDICAID special adjustor payments each year authorized in
 the department of community health appropriations act.

3 (E) (d) "Michigan merit award trust fund" means the Michigan
4 merit award trust fund established in section 9.

5 (F) (e) "Residual tobacco settlement revenue" means any
6 residual interests, as defined by the Michigan tobacco settlement
7 finance authority act, that are received by this state.

8 (G) (f) "Tobacco settlement revenue" means money received by this state that is attributable to the master settlement agreement 9 10 incorporated into a consent decree and final judgment entered into 11 on December 7, 1998 in Kelly Ex Rel. Michigan v Philip Morris 12 Incorporated, et al., Ingham county COUNTY circuit court, docket 13 no. 96-84281CZ, including any rights to receive money attributable 14 to the master settlement agreement that has been sold by this 15 state.

(H) (g) "21st century jobs trust fund" means the 21st century
 jobs trust fund established in section 7.

18 Sec. 6. The legislature shall authorize the expenditure of 19 medicaid MEDICAID benefits trust fund revenues through an 20 appropriation act only for 1 or more of the following purposes:

(a) To finance a shortfall in the medicaid MEDICAID program
due to a disallowance of medicaid MEDICAID payments from the
federal government.

(b) To offset any decline in revenue caused by federal
 medicaid MEDICAID policy changes.

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(C) FOR ANY OTHER PURPOSE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.

27 SEC. 11. (1) THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE

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1 STATE TREASURY.

(2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM
ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND. THE STATE
TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND.
THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND
INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM HEALTH SERVICES FUND INVESTMENTS.

7 (3) MONEY IN THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE
8 FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND AND SHALL NOT
9 LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

10 (4) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL BE THE ADMINISTRATOR OF
 11 THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND FOR AUDITING PURPOSES.

12 (5) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY SHALL EXPEND MONEY FROM THE 13 HEALTH SERVICES FUND, UPON APPROPRIATION, ONLY AS PROVIDED IN THIS 14 SECTION. ON THE FIRST DAY OF EACH MONTH, THE STATE TREASURER SHALL 15 MAKE A DISTRIBUTION FROM THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND IN THE FOLLOWING 16 ORDER OF PRIORITY:

(A) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, \$2,000,000.00 TO THE FUND DESCRIBED 17 18 IN SECTION 5402 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL 19 PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.5402. THE FUNDS DISTRIBUTED SUBJECT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE USED EXCLUSIVELY FOR ASSISTING 20 21 OUALIFIED WATER SUPPLIERS IN SATISFYING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE 22 FEDERAL SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5402 OF THE 23 NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, 24 MCL 324.5402, AND FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF LOW-INTEREST LOANS AND 25 GRANTS TO COMMUNITY AND NONCOMMUNITY QUALIFIED WATER SUPPLIERS. (B) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, NOT LESS THAN \$100,000,000.00 SHALL 26

27 BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR

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COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH NON-MEDICAID SERVICES. NO LESS THAN 5% OF
 THE FUNDS DISTRIBUTED SUBJECT TO THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE USED TO
 SUPPORT STATEWIDE ADVERSE CHILDHOOD EXPERIENCE INTERVENTION
 SERVICES.

5 (C) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, \$30,000,000.00 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED
6 TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR LOCAL PUBLIC
7 HEALTH FOR NON-MEDICAID SERVICES.

8 (D) PER STATE FISCAL YEAR, EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN 9 THIS SUBDIVISION, NOT LESS THAN \$204,000,000.00 SHALL BE 10 DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE 11 FEDERAL MEDICARE PHARMACEUTICAL PROGRAM. FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2016-12 2017 ONLY, NOT LESS THAN \$150,000,000.00 SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO 13 THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE FEDERAL 14 MEDICARE PHARMACEUTICAL PROGRAM.

15 (E) AFTER THE DISTRIBUTIONS DESCRIBED IN SUBDIVISIONS (A) TO 16 (D), AN AMOUNT THAT EQUALS THE REMAINING FUNDS AVAILABLE SHALL BE 17 DISTRIBUTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS FOR CLINICAL AND 18 MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES.

19 (6) MONEY DEPOSITED INTO THE HEALTH SERVICES FUND PURSUANT TO 20 THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE USED FOR ANY MEDICAID BENEFITS PROVIDED 21 UNDER THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CREATED UNDER SECTIONS 105 AND 22 105D OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.105 AND 23 400.105D, OR FOR THE MEDICAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION WITHIN THE 24 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF 25 THE MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CREATED UNDER SECTIONS 105 AND 105D OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE ACT, 1939 PA 280, MCL 400.105 AND 400.105D. 26 Enacting section 1.
