## HOUSE BILL No. 4074

## January 27, 2015, Introduced by Rep. Dianda and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"

by amending section 541 (MCL 436.1541), as amended by 2008 PA 489.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 541. (1) The commission shall not prohibit an applicant
 for or the holder of a specially designated distributor license or
 specially designated merchant license from owning or operating
 motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed premises,
 if both of the following conditions are met:

(a) One or both of the following conditions exist:

7 (i) The applicant or licensee is located in a neighborhood
8 shopping center composed of 1 or more commercial establishments
9 organized or operated as a unit which THAT is related in location,
10 size, and type of shop to the trade area that the unit serves,

which THAT provides not less than 50,000 square feet of gross
 leasable retail space, and which THAT provides 5 private off-street
 parking spaces for each 1,000 square feet of gross leasable retail
 space.

5 (ii) The applicant or licensee maintains a minimum inventory on
6 the premises, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel, of
7 not less than \$250,000.00, at cost, of those goods and services
8 customarily marketed by approved types of businesses.

9 (b) The site of payment and selection of alcoholic liquor is
10 not less than 50 feet from that point where motor vehicle fuel is
11 dispensed.

12 (2) The commission shall not prohibit an applicant for or the 13 holder of a specially designated distributor license or specially 14 designated merchant license from owning or operating motor vehicle 15 fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed premises, if all of the 16 following conditions are met:

17 (a) The applicant is located in a township with a population
18 of 7,000 or less , which township THAT is not contiguous with any
19 other township. For purposes of this subdivision, a township is not
20 considered contiguous by water.

(b) The applicant or licensee maintains a minimum inventory on the premises, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel, of not less than \$12,500.00 at cost, of those goods and services customarily marketed by approved types of businesses.

(c) The applicant has the approval of the township, as
evidenced by a resolution duly adopted by the township and
submitted with the application to the commission.

(3) The commission shall not prohibit an applicant for or the
 holder of a specially designated merchant license from owning or
 operating motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed
 premises if both EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:

(A) BOTH of the following conditions are met:

6 (i) (a) The applicant or licensee is located in either of the
7 following:

8 (A) (i) A city, incorporated village, or township with a
9 population of 3,500 or less and a county with a population of
10 31,000 or more.

(B) (*ii*) A city, incorporated village, or township with a
population of 4,000 or less and a county with a population of less
than 31,000.

(*ii*) (*b*) The applicant or licensee maintains a minimum
inventory on the premises, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor
vehicle fuel, of not less than \$10,000.00, at cost, of those goods
and services customarily marketed by approved types of businesses.

(B) THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE IS LOCATED IN A TOWNSHIP WITH A
POPULATION DENSITY OF LESS THAN 4 PEOPLE PER SQUARE MILE AND COUNTY
WITH A POPULATION DENSITY OF LESS THAN 11 PEOPLE PER SQUARE MILE.

(4) The commission shall not prohibit an applicant for or the holder of a specially designated distributor license from owning or operating motor vehicle fuel pumps on or adjacent to the licensed premises if both of the following conditions are met:

25 (a) The applicant or licensee is located in either of the26 following:

(i) A city, incorporated village, or township with a population

1 of 3,500 or less and a county with a population of 31,000 or more.

2 (*ii*) A city, incorporated village, or township with a
3 population of 4,000 or less and a county with a population of less
4 than 31,000.

5 (b) The applicant or licensee maintains a minimum inventory on
6 the premises, excluding alcoholic liquor and motor vehicle fuel, of
7 not less than \$12,500.00, at cost, of those goods and services
8 customarily marketed by approved types of businesses.

9 (5) A person who THAT was issued a specially designated
10 merchant license or specially designated distributor license at a
11 location at which another person owned, operated or maintained
12 motor vehicle fuel pumps at the same location may have or acquire
13 an interest in the ownership, operation or maintenance of those
14 motor vehicle fuel pumps.

15 (6) The commission may transfer ownership of a specially 16 designated merchant license or specially designated distributor 17 license to a person who THAT owns or is acquiring an interest in 18 motor vehicle fuel pumps already in operation at the same location 19 at which the license is issued.
