(MCL 211.1 to 211.155) by adding section 7ll.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 7ll. AN ELIGIBLE WIND ENERGY CONVERSION DEVICE INSTALLED
- 2 ON REAL PROPERTY CLASSIFIED AS RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY OR
- 3 AGRICULTURAL REAL PROPERTY UNDER SECTION 34C IS EXEMPT FROM THE
- 4 COLLECTION OF TAXES UNDER THIS ACT. AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 5 (A) "ELIGIBLE WIND ENERGY CONVERSION DEVICE" MEANS A SMALL-
- 6 SCALE WIND ENERGY CONVERSION DEVICE THAT MEETS ALL STANDARDS FOR A
- 7 WIND ENERGY CONVERSION DEVICE PRESCRIBED BY THE MICHIGAN NEXT
- 8 ENERGY AUTHORITY AND IS CERTIFIED BY THE UNITED STATES
- 9 ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY.
 - (B) "MICHIGAN NEXT ENERGY AUTHORITY" MEANS THE MICHIGAN NEXT ENERGY AUTHORITY CREATED IN SECTION 3 OF THE MICHIGAN NEXT ENERGY

- 2 (C) "SMALL-SCALE" MEANS HAVING A NAMEPLATE GENERATING CAPACITY
- 3 OF NOT MORE THAN 150 KILOWATTS.
- 4 (D) "WIND ENERGY CONVERSION DEVICE" MEANS A MECHANISM OR
- 5 SERIES OF MECHANISMS DESIGNED PRIMARILY TO COLLECT, CONVERT,
- 6 TRANSFER, OR STORE FOR FUTURE USE WIND ENERGY FOR THE PURPOSES OF
- 7 HEATING, COOLING, OR ELECTRIC SUPPLY, BUT NOT THOSE PARTS OF A
- 8 HEATING, COOLING, OR ELECTRIC SUPPLY SYSTEM THAT WOULD BE REQUIRED
- 9 REGARDLESS OF THE ENERGY SOURCE BEING UTILIZED.
