A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1220.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1220. (1) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL NOT ADOPT OR OPERATE UNDER 2 A DEFICIT BUDGET, AND A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 3 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL NOT INCUR AN OPERATING 4 DEFICIT IN A FUND DURING A SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR. IF A SCHOOL 5 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY 6 HAS AN EXISTING DEFICIT FUND BALANCE, INCURS A DEFICIT FUND BALANCE 7 IN THE MOST RECENTLY COMPLETED SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR, OR ADOPTS A 8 9 CURRENT YEAR BUDGET THAT PROJECTS A DEFICIT FUND BALANCE, ALL OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY: 10

(A) THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR 1 2 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL NOTIFY THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 3 INSTRUCTION AND THE STATE TREASURER IMMEDIATELY UPON THE OCCURRENCE 4 OF THE CIRCUMSTANCE. A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE 5 NOTICE UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE INTERMEDIATE SUPERINTENDENT OF 6 THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS LOCATED. A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL PROVIDE A COPY OF THE NOTICE 7 UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE AUTHORIZING BODY OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL 8 9 ACADEMY.

10 (B) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER MAKING NOTIFICATION UNDER SUBDIVISION (A), THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC 11 12 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 13 INSTRUCTION AND THE STATE TREASURER A PREPLAN FINANCIAL REPORT IN 14 THE FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. 15 BEFORE SUBMISSION TO THE STATE TREASURER, A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE MEMBERS 16 17 OF THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND TO THE INTERMEDIATE 18 SUPERINTENDENT OF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE 19 SCHOOL DISTRICT IS LOCATED, AN INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL 20 TRANSMIT A COPY OF A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION TO THE MEMBERS 21 OF THE BOARD OF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, AND A PUBLIC 22 SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF A REPORT UNDER THIS 23 SUBDIVISION TO THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL 24 ACADEMY AND ITS AUTHORIZING BODY.

25 (C) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER NOTIFYING THE DEPARTMENT, THE SCHOOL
26 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
27 SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION IN THE

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1 FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE DEPARTMENT AN AMENDED BUDGET FOR 2 THE CURRENT SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR AND A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN 3 APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, WITH A COPY TO THE STATE 4 5 TREASURER. A SCHOOL DISTRICT SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF THE AMENDED 6 BUDGET AND THE DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN TO THE INTERMEDIATE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT IN WHICH THE 7 SCHOOL DISTRICT IS LOCATED. A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL TRANSMIT 8 9 A COPY OF THE AMENDED BUDGET AND THE DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN TO 10 ITS AUTHORIZING BODY.

(D) THE DEPARTMENT MAY WITHHOLD AND RELEASE SOME OR ALL OF THE
MONEY PAYABLE TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT,
OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY AS PROVIDED UNDER SECTION 102 OF THE STATE
SCHOOL AID ACT OF 1979, MCL 388.1702.

15 (E) THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION MAY REQUIRE A
16 DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN TO INCLUDE AN ACADEMIC PLAN FOR THE SCHOOL
17 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.

(F) AFTER THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION APPROVES A
SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL
ACADEMY'S DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT,

21 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL POST
22 THE DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN ON THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, INTERMEDIATE
23 SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY'S WEBSITE.

(2) TO ASSURE GREATER COORDINATION AND EFFECTIVE PARTNERSHIPS
IN THE DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN
UNDER SUBSECTION (1), WHEN ADMINISTERING SUBSECTIONS (1), (4), AND
(5), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL CONSULT WITH ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:

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(A) THE DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY.

2 (B) THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR
3 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN

9 (D) FOR A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT 10 ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE AUTHORIZING BODY OF THE 11 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.

12 (3) NOT LATER THAN MARCH 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL 13 PREPARE A REPORT OF DEFICITS INCURRED OR PROJECTED BY SCHOOL 14 DISTRICTS, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND PUBLIC SCHOOL 15 ACADEMIES IN THE IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING FISCAL YEAR AND THE PROGRESS MADE IN REDUCING THOSE DEFICITS AND SUBMIT THE REPORT TO THE 16 17 STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE LEGISLATURE RESPONSIBLE FOR K-12 18 EDUCATION LEGISLATION, THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEES OF THE 19 LEGISLATURE RESPONSIBLE FOR K-12 SCHOOL AID APPROPRIATIONS, THE 20 HOUSE AND SENATE FISCAL AGENCIES, THE STATE TREASURER, AND THE 21 STATE BUDGET DIRECTOR. THE DEPARTMENT ALSO SHALL SUBMIT QUARTERLY 22 INTERIM REPORTS CONCERNING THE PROGRESS MADE BY SCHOOL DISTRICTS, 23 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICTS, AND PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMIES IN 24 REDUCING THOSE DEFICITS TO THE STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE 25 LEGISLATURE RESPONSIBLE FOR K-12 EDUCATION LEGISLATION, THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEES OF THE LEGISLATURE RESPONSIBLE FOR K-26 12 SCHOOL AID APPROPRIATIONS, THE HOUSE AND SENATE FISCAL AGENCIES, 27

THE STATE TREASURER, AND THE STATE BUDGET DIRECTOR. ON A QUARTERLY
 BASIS, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL PUBLICLY
 PRESENT THOSE REPORTS TO THE APPROPRIATIONS SUBCOMMITTEES OF THE
 LEGISLATURE RESPONSIBLE FOR K-12 SCHOOL AID APPROPRIATIONS.

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5 (4) A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC 6 SCHOOL ACADEMY REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 7 INSTRUCTION AND THE STATE TREASURER A MONTHLY MONITORING REPORT ON 8 9 REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE 10 DEPARTMENT AND SHALL POST THESE REPORTS ON ITS WEBSITE. A SCHOOL 11 DISTRICT SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF EACH REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION 12 TO THE INTERMEDIATE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 13 DISTRICT IN WHICH THE SCHOOL DISTRICT IS LOCATED. A PUBLIC SCHOOL 14 ACADEMY SHALL TRANSMIT A COPY OF EACH REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION TO 15 THE AUTHORIZING BODY OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY. A SCHOOL DISTRICT MAY CONTRACT WITH ITS INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT OR 16 17 ANOTHER ENTITY TO PROVIDE THE MONTHLY MONITORING REPORT.

18 (5) IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR 19 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A DEFICIT ELIMINATION 20 PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION, AND THE DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN IS 21 APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC 22 INSTRUCTION MAY CONTINUE ALLOTMENT AND PAYMENT OF FUNDS AS PROVIDED 23 UNDER SECTION 102 OF THE STATE SCHOOL AID ACT OF 1979, MCL 24 388.1702. WHEN APPROVING A DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN, THE 25 SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION SHALL ESTABLISH THE PERIOD OF 26 TIME WITHIN WHICH A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, 27 OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY MUST ELIMINATE ITS DEFICIT AND MAY SET

SPECIAL CONDITIONS THAT THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 1 2 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY MUST MEET WHILE THE DEFICIT 3 ELIMINATION PLAN IS IN EFFECT. AFTER THE DEPARTMENT APPROVES A 4 SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL 5 ACADEMY'S DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE 6 SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY SHALL POST THE DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN ON THE SCHOOL 7 8 DISTRICT'S, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL 9 ACADEMY'S WEBSITE. THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION RELATING TO A 10 DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN DO NOT APPLY TO A SCHOOL DISTRICT, 11 INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IF THE 12 SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL 13 ACADEMY IS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AN ENHANCED DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER SUBSECTION (6). 14

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15 (6) IF, BASED UPON INFORMATION INCLUDED IN A PERIODIC 16 FINANCIAL STATUS REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SECTION 1219, A PREPLAN 17 FINANCIAL REPORT REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, A DEFICIT ELIMINATION 18 PLAN REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION, OR A REQUEST BY THE 19 SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, THE STATE TREASURER 20 DETERMINES THAT A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR 21 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY IS SUBJECT TO RAPIDLY DETERIORATING FINANCIAL 22 CIRCUMSTANCES, PERSISTENTLY DECLINING ENROLLMENT, OR OTHER 23 INDICATORS OF FINANCIAL STRESS LIKELY TO RESULT IN RECURRING 24 OPERATING DEFICITS OR RECURRING FINANCIAL STRESS WITHIN THE SCHOOL 25 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, 26 THE STATE TREASURER MAY REQUIRE THE SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE 27 SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY TO SUBMIT AN ENHANCED

1 DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN IN THE FORM AND MANNER DETERMINED BY THE 2 DEPARTMENT OF TREASURY. AN ENHANCED DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN SHALL 3 PROVIDE FOR THE RESOLUTION OF THE DETERIORATING FINANCIAL 4 CIRCUMSTANCES, PERSISTENTLY DECLINING ENROLLMENT, OR OTHER INDICATORS OF RECURRING OPERATING DEFICITS OR RECURRING FINANCIAL 5 6 STRESS AND IS SUBJECT TO APPROVAL BY THE STATE TREASURER. AS A CONDITION OF APPROVING THE ENHANCED DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN, THE 7 STATE TREASURER MAY REQUIRE A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 8 9 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY REQUIRED TO SUBMIT AN ENHANCED 10 DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN UNDER THIS SECTION TO ENTER INTO A 11 FINANCIAL RECOVERY AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE TREASURER. A FINANCIAL 12 RECOVERY AGREEMENT MAY PROVIDE FOR, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, ALL OF 13 THE FOLLOWING:

8 (D) "ENHANCED DEFICIT ELIMINATION PLAN" MEANS MEASURES 9 REQUIRED BY THE STATE TREASURER UNDER THIS SECTION TO ADDRESS THE 10 FINANCIAL CONDITIONS WITHIN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL 11 DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY AND RESOLVE ANY DEFICIT WITHIN 12 THE TIME PERIOD PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE TREASURER.

(E) "PREPLAN FINANCIAL REPORT" MEANS A REPORT ON THE FINANCIAL 13 14 CONDITIONS WITHIN A SCHOOL DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, 15 OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION AND SUBMITTED IN A FORM AND MANNER PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE TREASURER, WHICH MAY 16 INCLUDE, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, FINANCIAL DATA AND OTHER 17 INFORMATION ON LIABILITIES, PAYMENTS, ENROLLMENT, BORROWING, AND 18 19 OTHER CRITERIA RELATING TO THE FINANCIAL CONDITIONS WITHIN A SCHOOL 20 DISTRICT, INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY.
