THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1566. IF A PUBLIC SCHOOL GIVES AN AWARD OR OTHER
- 2 RECOGNITION TO PUPILS FOR WHICH SCHOOL ATTENDANCE IS A FACTOR,
- 3 SCHOOL OFFICIALS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL NOT COUNT A PUPIL'S
- 4 ABSENCE THAT IS DUE TO A RELIGIOUS HOLIDAY OR OTHER RELIGIOUS
- 5 OBSERVANCE AS AN ABSENCE IN THE PUPIL'S SCHOOL ATTENDANCE RECORD
- 6 FOR THE PURPOSES OF DETERMINING ELIGIBILITY FOR THE AWARD OR OTHER
- 7 RECOGNITION.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
 - after the date it is enacted into law.
