- 1 SEC. 64A. (1) BY OCTOBER 1, 2016, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP
- 2 POLICIES TO ENSURE THAT AN INMATE, INCLUDING AN INMATE IN PUNITIVE
- 3 OR ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION, WHO IS LESS THAN 21 YEARS OF AGE IS
- 4 OFFERED AGE-APPROPRIATE OUT-OF-CELL PROGRAMMING AND OUTDOOR
- 5 EXERCISE NOT LESS THAN 5 DAYS A WEEK.
- 6 (2) BY JANUARY 1, 2017, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP POLICIES
- 7 TO ENSURE THAT AN INMATE, INCLUDING AN INMATE IN PUNITIVE OR
- 8 ADMINISTRATIVE SEGREGATION, WHO IS LESS THAN 21 YEARS OF AGE IS
- 9 RELEASED FROM HIS OR HER CELL EACH DAY. THE POLICIES DEVELOPED BY
- 10 THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE BASED ON THE
- 11 GUIDELINES FOR THE USE OF RESTRAINT AND SECLUSION ESTABLISHED UNDER
