## HOUSE BILL No. 5225

## January 20, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Muxlow, Bizon, Glardon, Schor, Lauwers, Inman, Pagel and Hooker and referred to the Committee on Tax Policy.

A bill to establish the P.C.U.P.S. foundation fund in the department of treasury; to provide for the distribution of the money from the fund; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain agencies and officials; and to provide for appropriations.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	Sec. 1	. This ac	t shall	be	known	and	may	be	cited	as	the
2	"P.C.U.P.S.	foundati	on fund	act	".						

Sec. 3. As used in this act:

(a) "Department" means the department of treasury.

(b) "Fund" means the P.C.U.P.S. foundation fund created in section 5.

(c) "P.C.U.P.S" means prostate cancer understanding prevention screenings.

Sec. 5. (1) The P.C.U.P.S. foundation fund is created in the

1 department to provide funds for donation to the P.C.U.P.S.

2 Foundation to assist the P.C.U.P.S. Foundation in promoting men's
3 health and wellness through early detection screening and knowledge
4 of symptoms, treatments, and care.

5 (2) The state treasurer shall credit to the fund all amounts
6 appropriated for this purpose under section 435 of the income tax
7 act of 1967, 1967 PA 281, MCL 206.435.

8 (3) The fund shall consist of the money credited to the fund
9 pursuant to section 435 of the income tax act of 1967, 1967 PA 281,
10 MCL 206.435, any interest and earnings accruing from the saving and
11 investment of that money, and other appropriations, money, or other
12 things of value received by the fund.

13 (4) The state treasurer shall direct the investment of the14 fund.

Sec. 7. (1) The money, interest, and earnings of the fund shall be expended solely for the purposes described in this act, including, but not limited to, the following:

18 (a) To educate men and women about prostate cancer.

19 (b) To promote "prostate blue" through sport and recreation.

20 (c) To increase awareness of prostate cancer month

21 (September).

22 (d) To save lives through early detection screenings.

23 (e) To seek healthier lifestyle through fundraising and24 philanthropy.

25 (2) Money granted or received as a gift or donation to the26 fund is available for distribution upon appropriation.

Sec. 9. Money from the fund may be used as matching funds for

a federal grant if those funds are to be used for the purposes
 described in this act.

3 Sec. 11. The money in the fund that is available for
4 distribution shall be appropriated each year. Money in the fund at
5 the close of the year shall remain in the fund and shall not lapse
6 to the general fund.

7 Enacting section 1. This act does not take effect unless
