## **HOUSE BILL No. 5330**

February 9, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Hughes and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to authorize the department of natural resources to convey property in Muskegon County; to prescribe conditions for the conveyance; and to provide for disposition of the revenue from the conveyance.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. The department of natural resources, on behalf of this
- 2 state, may convey to Sullivan Township, for consideration of \$1.00,
- 3 property, with improvements, that is under the jurisdiction of the
- 4 department of natural resources and located in Sullivan Township,
- 5 Muskegon County, Michigan, and described as follows:
- 5 That part of Section 11, T9N, R15W, Sullivan Township, Muskegon
- 7 County, Michigan, described as commencing at the East 1/4 corner of
  - said Section 11, thence run N88 27'52"W along the East and West 1/4

- 1 line of said Section 11 a distance of 2639.44 feet to the Center
- 2 1/4 corner of said Section 11: thence run S00 10'19"E along the
- 3 North and South 1/4 line of said Section 11 a distance of 90.15
- 4 feet to the South line of the Michigan Central Railway Company's
- 5 abandoned right-of-way; thence run S89 33'35"E along the said line
- 6 a distance of 296.55 feet; thence run S88 44'00"E along the said
- 7 line a distance of 362.71 feet to the point of beginning:
- 8 thence run S89 13'55"E a distance of 264.00 feet; thence run
- 9 S00 10'27"E a distance of 75.09 feet; thence run N89 18'23"W along
- 10 the said line a distance of 264.00 feet; thence run N00 10'27"W
- 11 along the said line a distance of 75.42 feet to the point of
- 12 beginning. Contains 0.45 acres of land more or less.
- Sec. 2. The conveyance authorized by section 1 shall provide
- 14 for all of the following:
- 15 (a) That the property must be used exclusively for public
- 16 recreation purposes and if any fee, term, or condition for the use
- 17 of the property is imposed on members of the public, or if any of
- 18 those fees, terms, or conditions are waived for use of the
- 19 property, resident and nonresident members of the public will be
- 20 subject to the same fees, terms, conditions, and waivers.
- 21 (b) That on termination of the use described in subdivision
- 22 (a) or if the property is used for any other purpose, this state
- 23 may reenter and repossess the property, terminating the grantee's
- 24 estate in the property.
- 25 (c) That if the grantee disputes this state's exercise of its
- 26 right of reentry and fails to promptly deliver possession of the

- 1 property to this state, the attorney general, on behalf of this
- 2 state, may bring an action to quiet title to, and regain possession
- 3 of, the property.
- 4 Sec. 3. (1) The department of natural resources shall deposit
- 5 the revenue received from the conveyance under section 1 in the
- 6 Michigan natural resources trust fund.
- 7 (2) The department of natural resources shall convey the
- 8 property as authorized by section 1 by quitclaim deed approved by
- 9 the attorney general.
- 10 (3) The department of natural resources shall retain to this
- 11 state the mineral rights to the property conveyed under section 1.
