A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 9208 (MCL 333.9208), as amended by 2013 PA 120.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 9208. (1) A parent, quardian, or person in loco parentis

- - (2) A teacher or principal shall not permit a child to enter or attend school unless a certificate indicating that a minimum of

- 1 dose of an immunizing agent against each of the diseases
- 2 specified by the department has been received and certified to by a
- 3 health professional or local health department. A parent, guardian,
- 4 or person in loco parentis having a child registered with only
- 5 these minimum doses of immunizing agents shall present an updated
- 6 certificate of immunization within 4 months after initial
- 7 attendance showing that the immunizations have been completed as
- 8 prescribed by the department.
- 9 (3) The department annually shall provide a report showing a
- 10 year-to-year comparison of the percentage of children by age who
- 11 are immunized appropriately upon entering the seventh grade.
- 12 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 13 after the date it is enacted into law.
- 14 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 15 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 5363 (request no.
